4. REVIEW OF THE SERVICE CHARGES TO SHELTERED AND SHELTERED WITH EXTRA CARE HOUSING

Resolved: That the Cabinet Member:

- i. Approved Option 3 to re-structure the service charge in order to accurately reflect the service provided.
- ii. Approved charging co-habitants £3 per week where both parties are in receipt of the service. This charge will be made directly by the Warden Call service.
- Reason: To ensure an equitable approach to service delivery regardless of tenure and that the service moves to a full cost recovery model to minimise the impact of the Housing Revenue Account and ensure the service charge is an accurate representation of the service provided.
