| Description | Three large sheets of paper one with smiley, blank and miserable <br> faces. Children have stickers to put on the face they feel summarises <br> their feelings about any subject discussed. |
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| Age Range | $2+$ |
| Time | 20 minutes |
| Cost | Cost of paper and stickers <br> Benefits <br> - Quick feedback on subjects <br> - Encourages the children to spend some time reflecting on what they <br> like and dislike <br> - Links to making a positive contribution, maths, personal social and <br> emotional development and a skilful communicator |
| Drawbacks | Children may put stickers on all faces and so may not give valid results <br> Other infoCan vary the activity depending on the age of children. Children can <br> draw their own happy/sad faces and have narrative to explain why. <br> Could have three large jars/containers what children could decorate <br> each one as happy, sad or indifferent then all the children are given a <br> ball and the topic is discussed and they place their ball in the container <br> which mirrors their feelings. |
