Comments/Observations:

Approval was given at the decision session on 4th December 2012 to advertise the Traffic Regulation Order for a proposed contra-flow cycle lane on Tanner Row between Rougier Street and North Street, and consult with residents, local businesses and relevant road user organisations. The contra-flow cycle lane would allow cyclists to travel against the one way flow of traffic on Tanner Row, between Rougier Street and North Street.

Consultation was carried out and one objection was received from a resident on Tanner Row raising a number of points. These have been outlined in the report accompanied by the officer comments.

Cabinet Member raised particular concern regarding the safety and considered all the evidence base information. He was reassured that the scheme would be closely monitored including another road safety audit soon after the scheme becomes operational.

<u>Decision</u>: Agreed to approve the making of the traffic regulation order advertised on the 18th January 2013 permitting cyclists to travel contra-flow (north east) on Tanner Row. This agreement is subject to close monitoring and another road safety audit taking place once operational.
