

ANNEX C

Representations received to a proposed Residents' Priority parking Scheme in the Micklegate Ward (Nunthorpe Crescent, Nunthorpe Drive, Nunthorpe View and Nunthorpe Gardens.

- 80 Properties were given details of the proposed scheme as outlined in Annex B.
- 49 of the 80 Households made representations to the proposal (61%)

Of these

- 22 households supported the implementation of a scheme as advertised.
- 9 households supported the implementation of a scheme operational Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm
- 18 households objected to the implementation of any Residents' Priority Parking Scheme. Two of these expressed a preference, should Resident parking be implemented, for a second choice option of Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm.
- There was no support for a scheme for the North side of Nunthorpe Crescent and Nunthorpe Gardens only.

31 households supported implementation of a Residents' Priority Parking Scheme, 18 objected.

The majority of support for the scheme was for the 7 day a week, 24 hour scheme as advertised.

The individual preferences of the residents are kept confidential – but details will be given to Councillors and the Director of City and Environmental Services for clarification during the decision process.
