Director agreed to implement the Speed Limit Order, as advertised recently under the *Notice of Proposals – The York Speed Limit (Amendment) (No 14/6) Order 2014*, which concerns applying a new 20mph speed limit to a number of additional residential streets, not covered by previous Speed Limit Orders, as detailed in the attached Annexes. In addition, with due consideration to the police’s comments, the council will monitor speeds on the three roads (*Hospital Fields Road, Heslington Road and Broad Highway*) following implementation of the new speed limits.
