## Reason for change

Inconsiderate parking causing access problems at the junction of Green Lane and Kingsthorpe (roundabout).

### **Initial Recommendation**

Introduce "no waiting at any time" restrictions (double yellow lines) to the standard distance for junction protection at the junction of Green Lane (northern part) and Kingsthorpe (west branch).



# **Objections**

One objection to the proposal was received. The objection was that the restrictions would simply displace parking further up Kingsthorpe.

### Recommendation

Reduce the restrictions slightly in length to minimise the problem (10m from kerbline)

Thank you for this email. The need for some double yellow lines at this point is important for safety at this junction. I feel that the adjustment in relation to the objection is an appropriate modification, and I hope that this will enable the proposal to go through.
