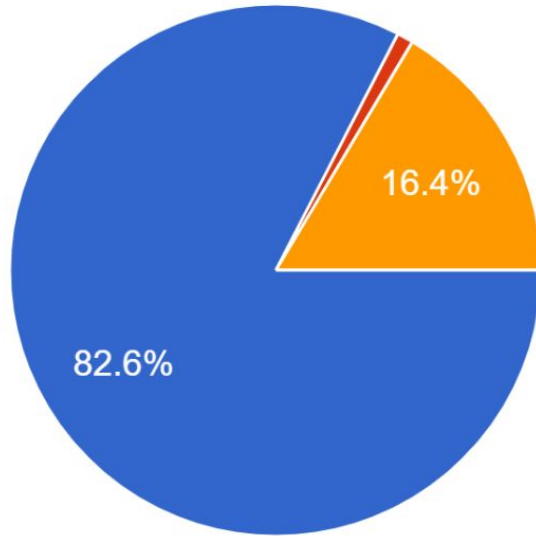

Bowls Pavilion building

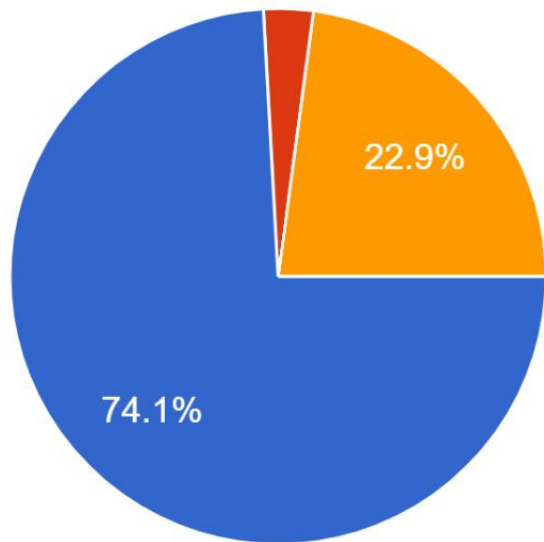


Pavilion building - public use or private use?

Pavilion building - where should proceeds be spent?

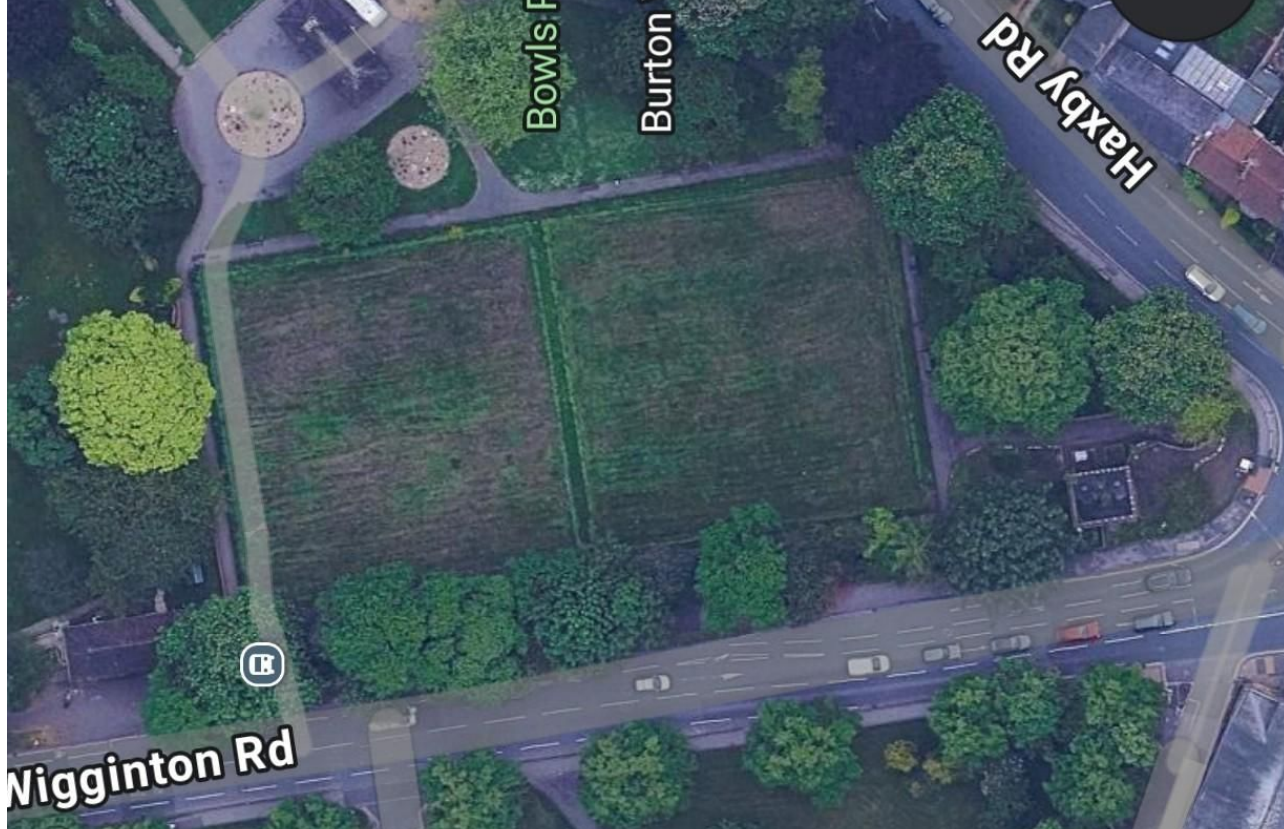


- I would prefer that any revenue be spent on the park

- Dog park/dog free area
- Quiet, undeveloped space
- Football, basketball, adult exercise equipment, croquet, mini golf, table tennis, skate park, corn hole
- Planting - trees, orchard, flowers, raised beds, sensory plants
- Performance space/band stand, picnic benches, reflective space, barbecue area
- Building - affordable housing, chapel

Other issues and ideas

- Litter bins, provide dog poo bags
- More picnic benches
- Access to toilets
- Fairs and other community events
- Anti-social behaviour, litter, drug taking, vandalism
- Lighting
- Pedestrian access to the park, surrounded by busy roads
