




Crime and ASB recorded for 3 Intake Ave, YORK Source: Police UK Crime Mapper



Edit crime type and time period












Crime changes over time in City of York and in the North Yorkshire force area



Crimes Committed Near Intake Avenue, York, YO30 6HB in May 2025

Summary

Intake Avenue, York, YO30 6HB is within the York Outer (North) policing neighbourhood, under the North Yorkshire Police force area.

There were **93** crimes recorded in May 2025 within half a mile of Intake Avenue, York, YO30 6HB.

Crime Level



YO30 6HB can be described as **Medium**.

In the previous 12 months for which data is available, there were 111 reported crimes per 1,000 people

This crime level rating is based on crimes in the Lower level Super Output Area (LSOA) that this postcode is within, whereas the crime map and the list of crimes shown below is based on a straight-line distance instead. Care should be taken when comparing rural to urban areas as even if crimes per 1,000 people are similar, the crimes will be geographically more spread out in rural areas and the LSOA will be a larger area.
