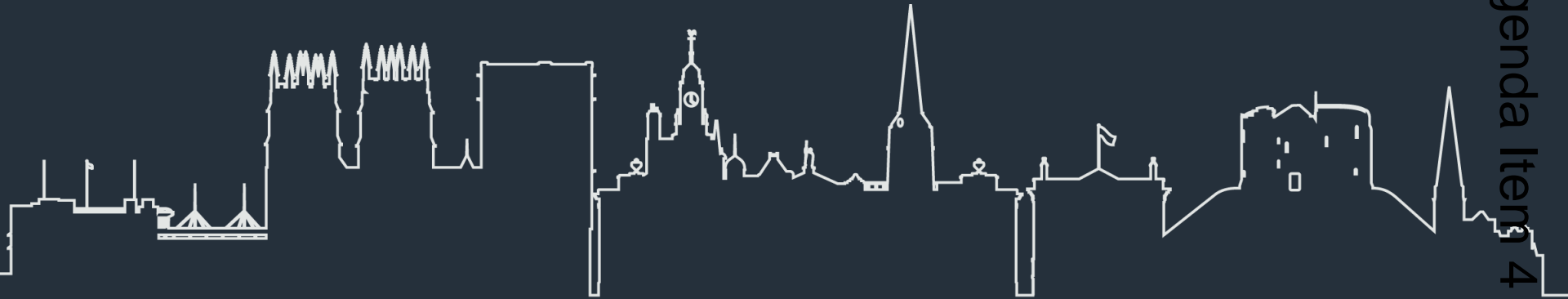

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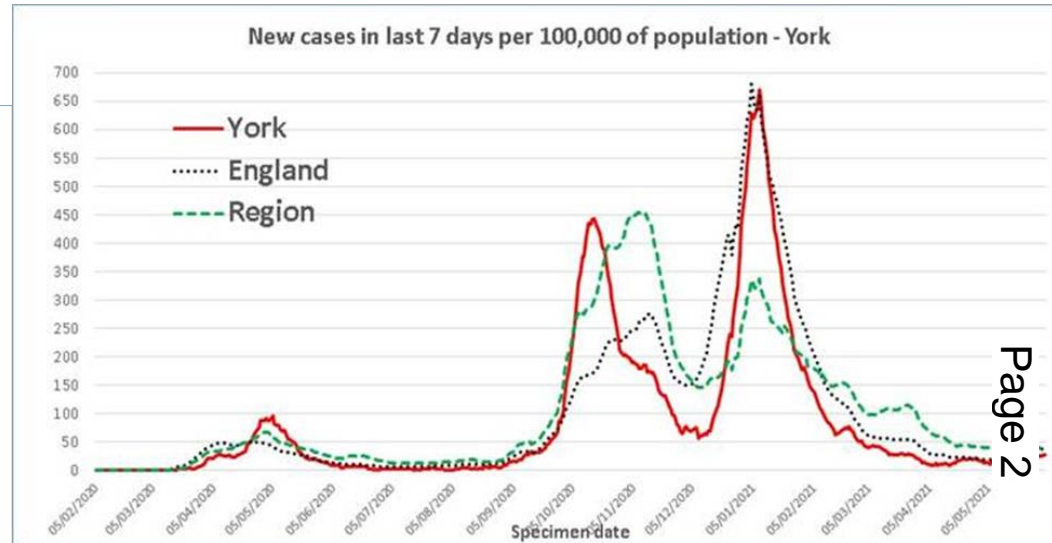
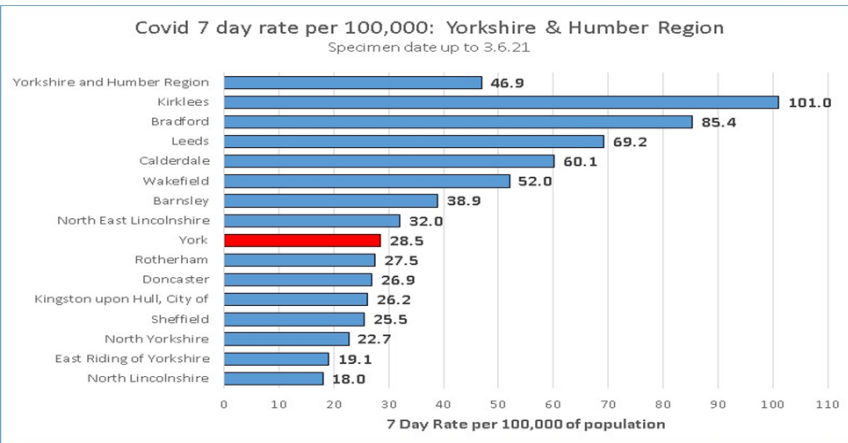

Position in Region

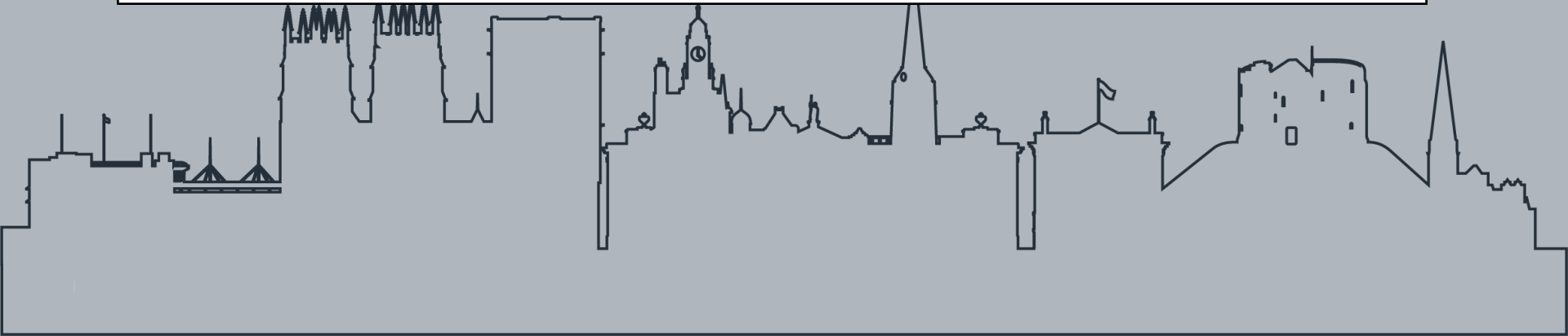
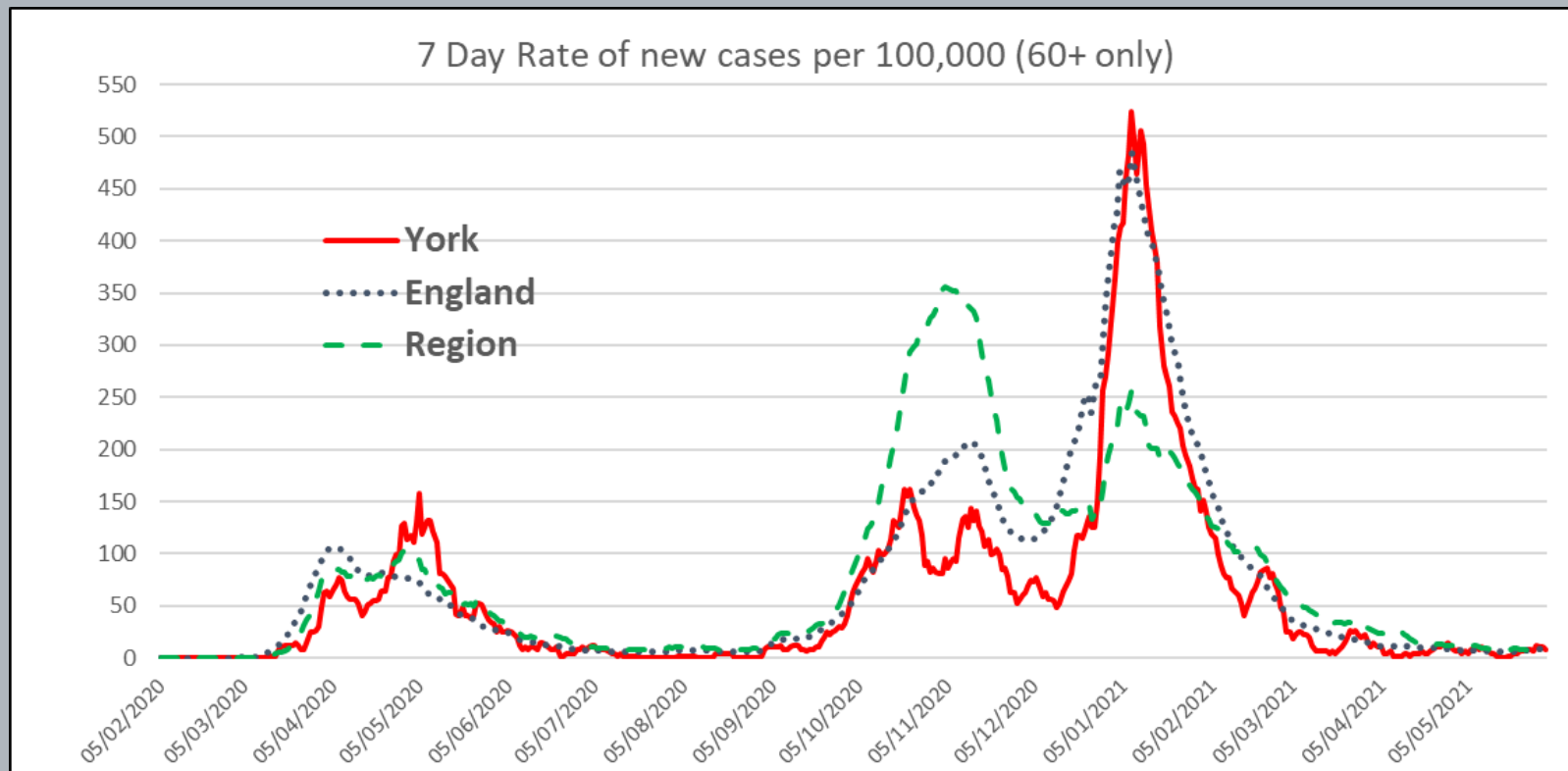
- Epidemic Curve

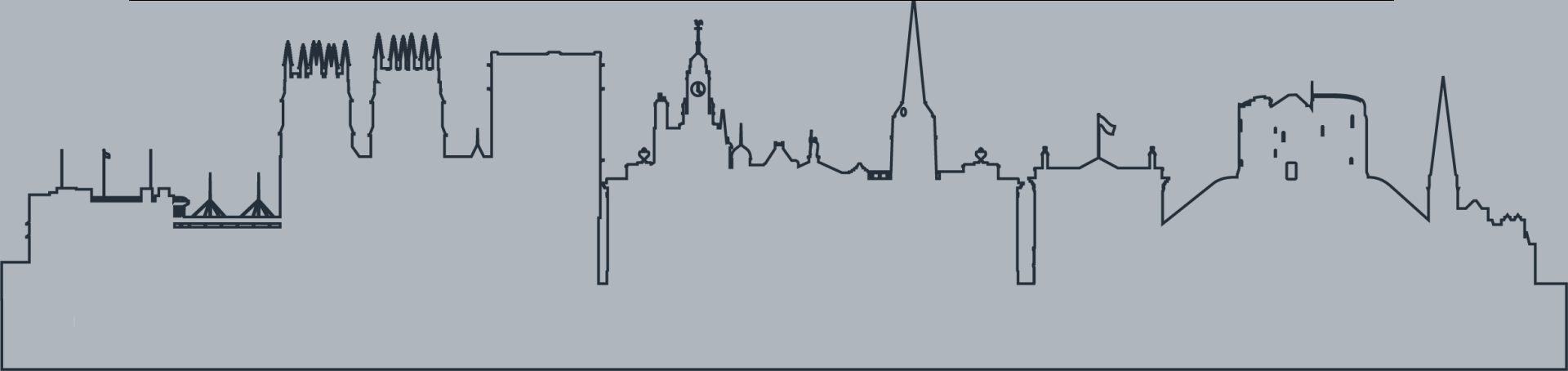
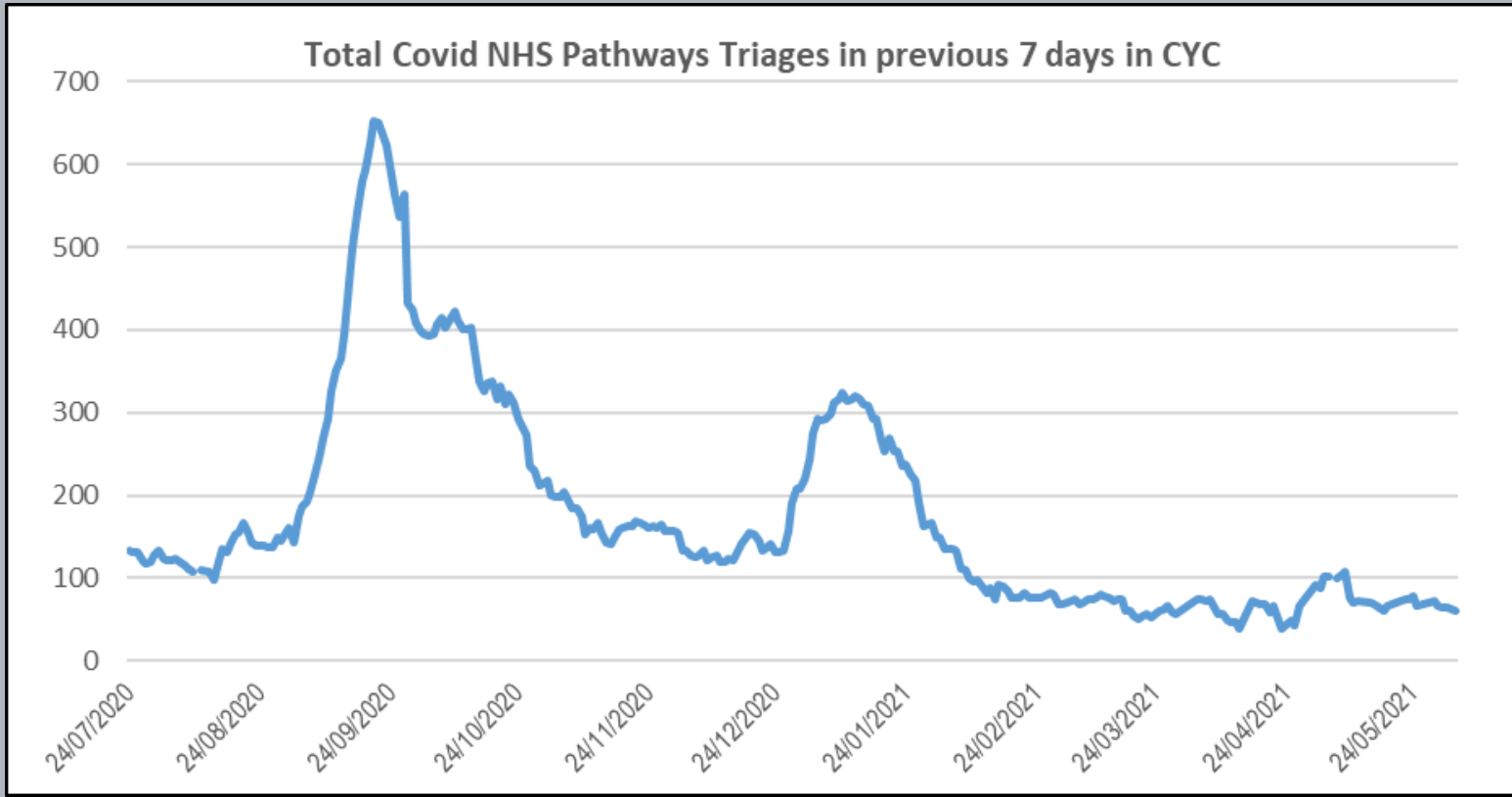


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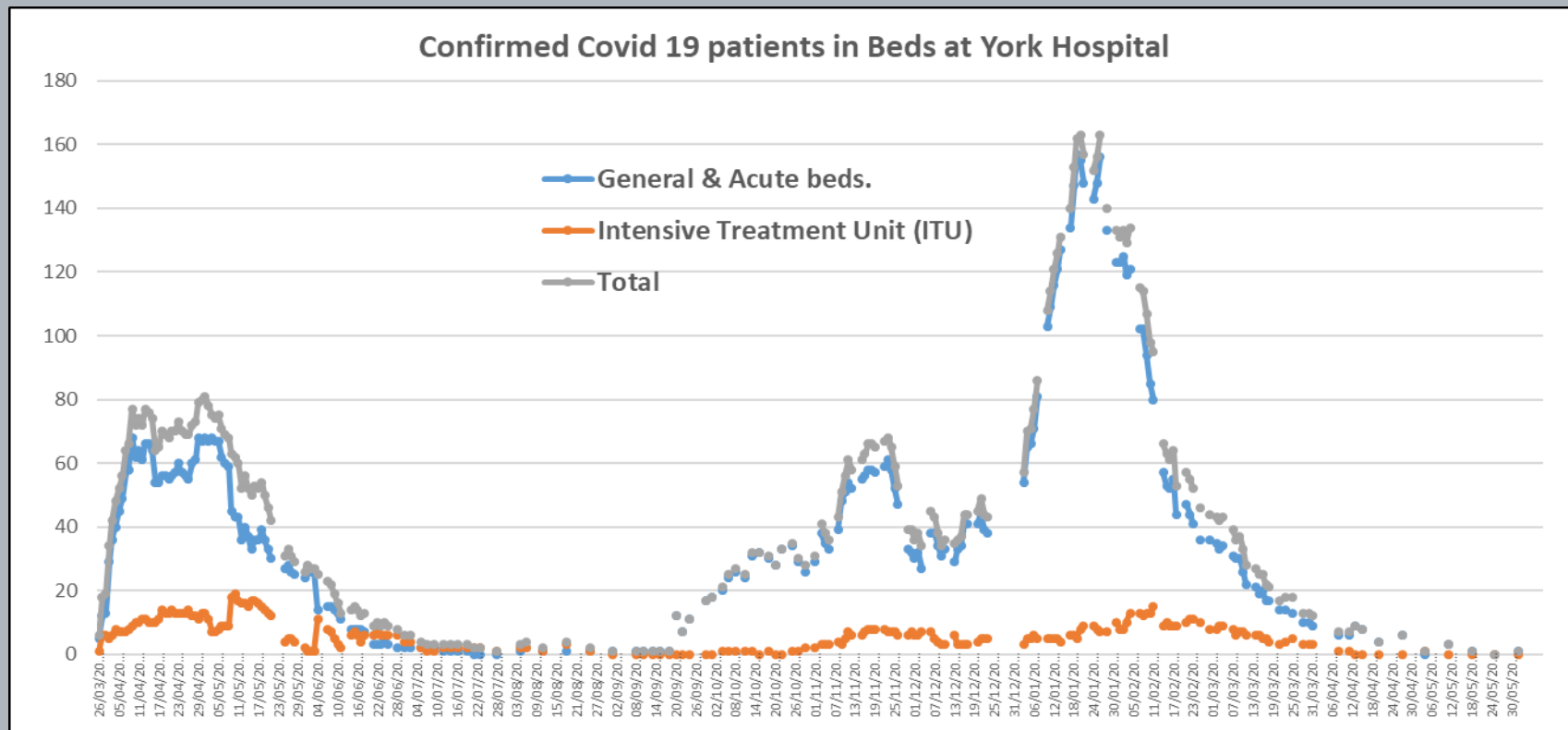
The latest official “validated” rate of new Covid cases per 100,000 of population for the period 28.5.21 to 3.6.21 in York was **28.5** (60 cases). The national and regional averages at this date were 44.2 and 46.9 respectively

The rate of new Covid cases per 100,000 of population for the period 1.6.21 to 8.6.21 for people aged 60+ in York was 6.1 (3 cases). The national and regional averages were 8.6 and 10.1 respectively.

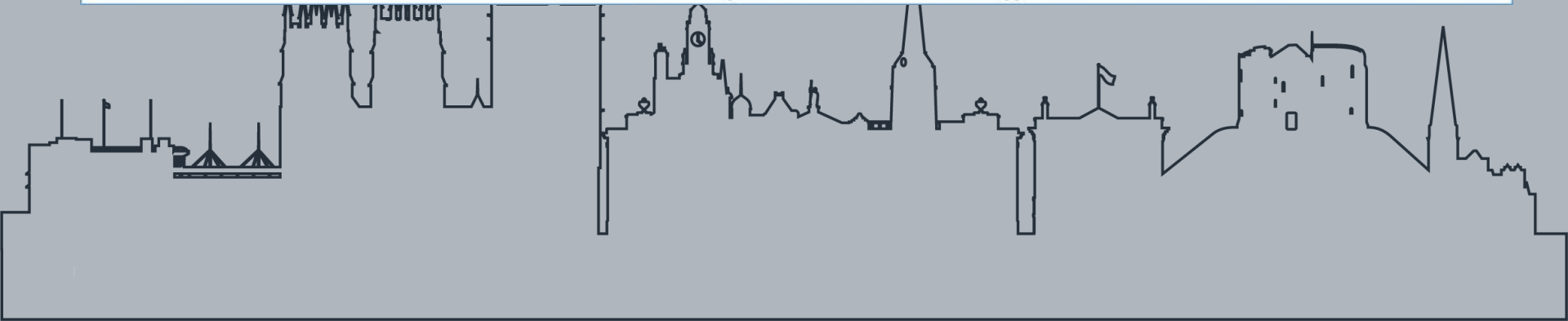
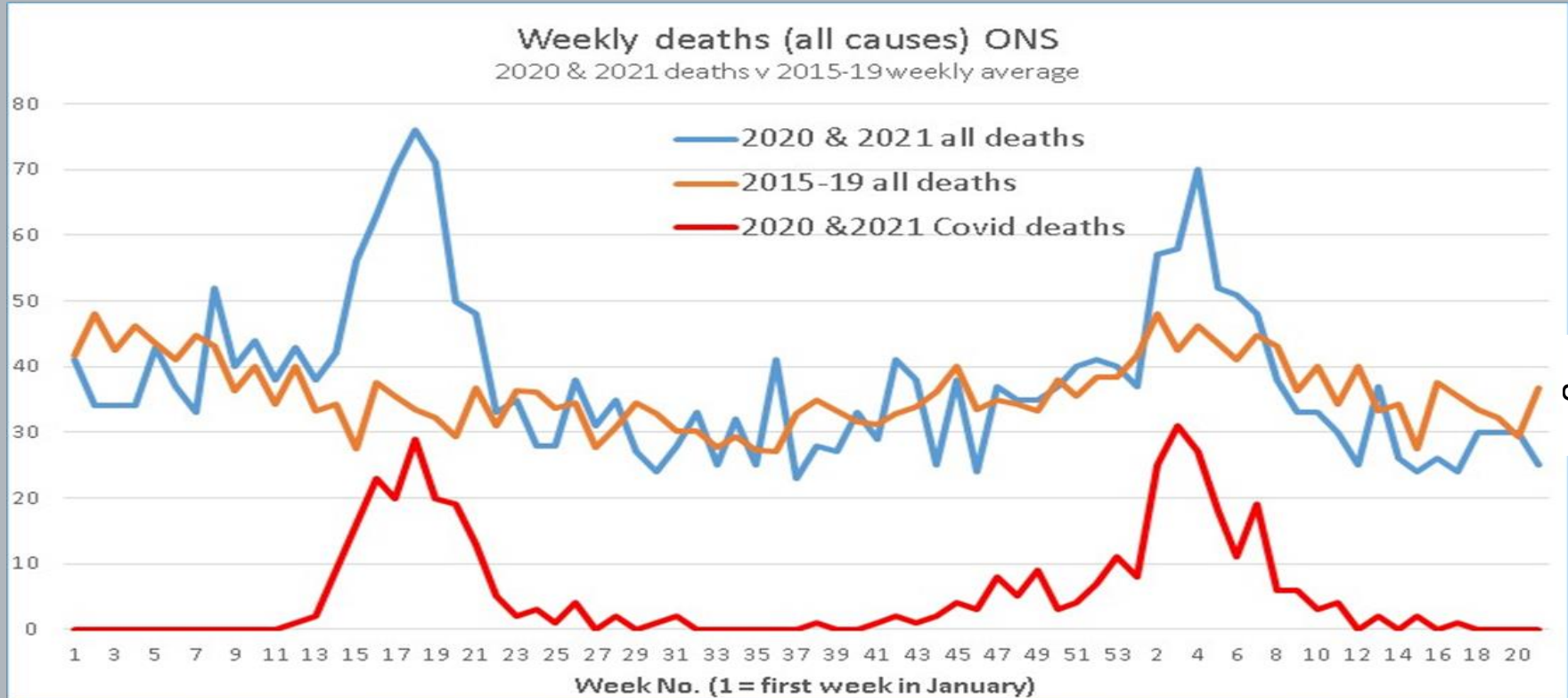




As at 1.6.21 there was 1 person with Covid in General and Acute beds and 0 in ITU.



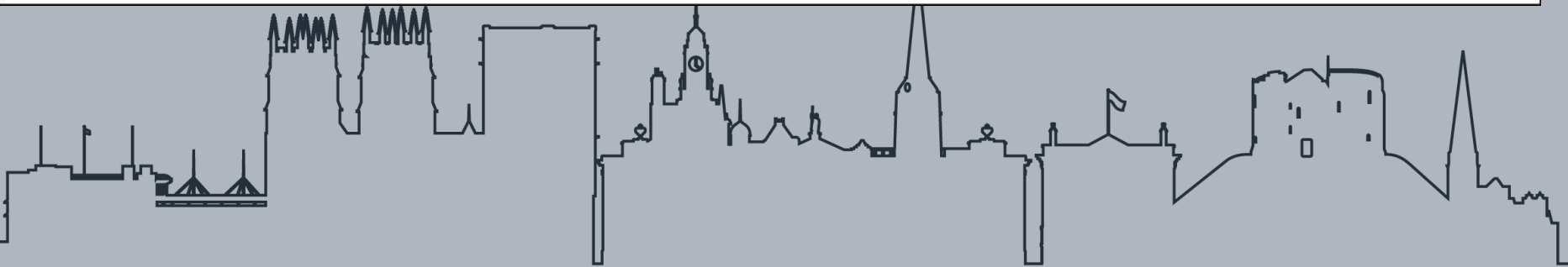
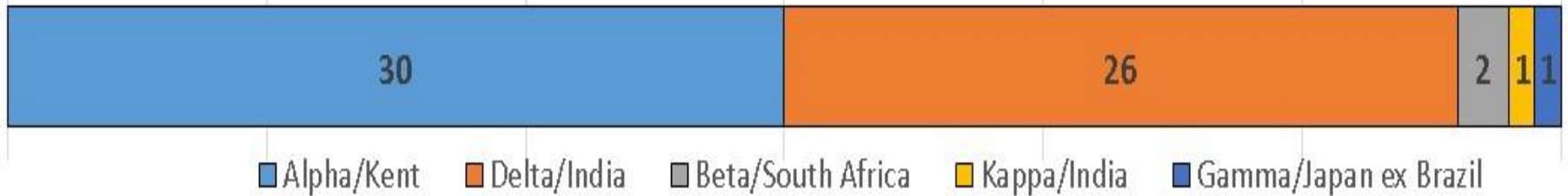
In the most recent period (Week 21: 22.5.21 to 28.5.21) **0** Covid-19 deaths were recorded as having occurred for CYC residents. The last death CYC was in week 17. There have been **140** 'excess deaths' in York since the start of the 2020 (using the 2015-2019 weekly average number of deaths as the comparator)



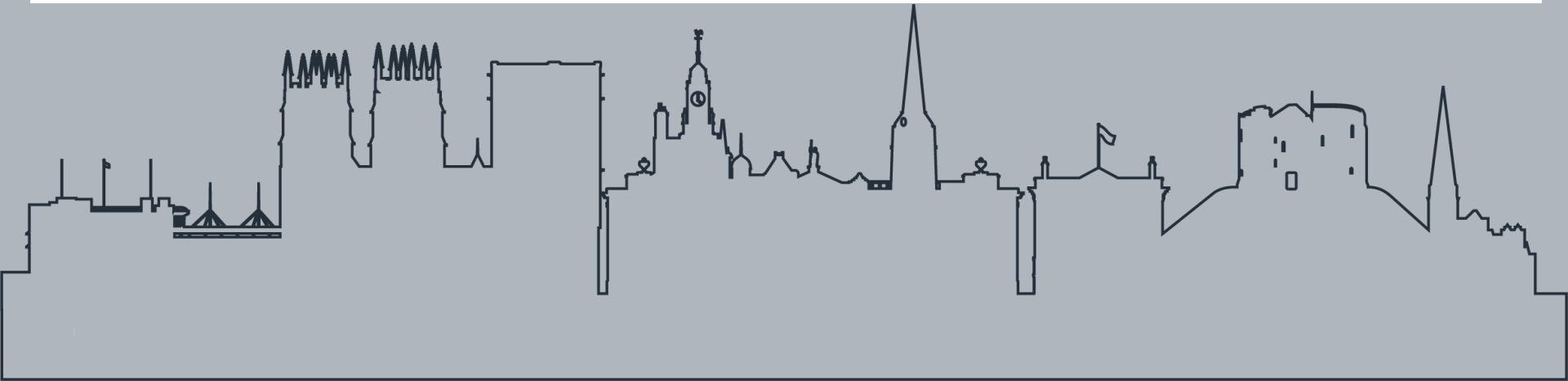
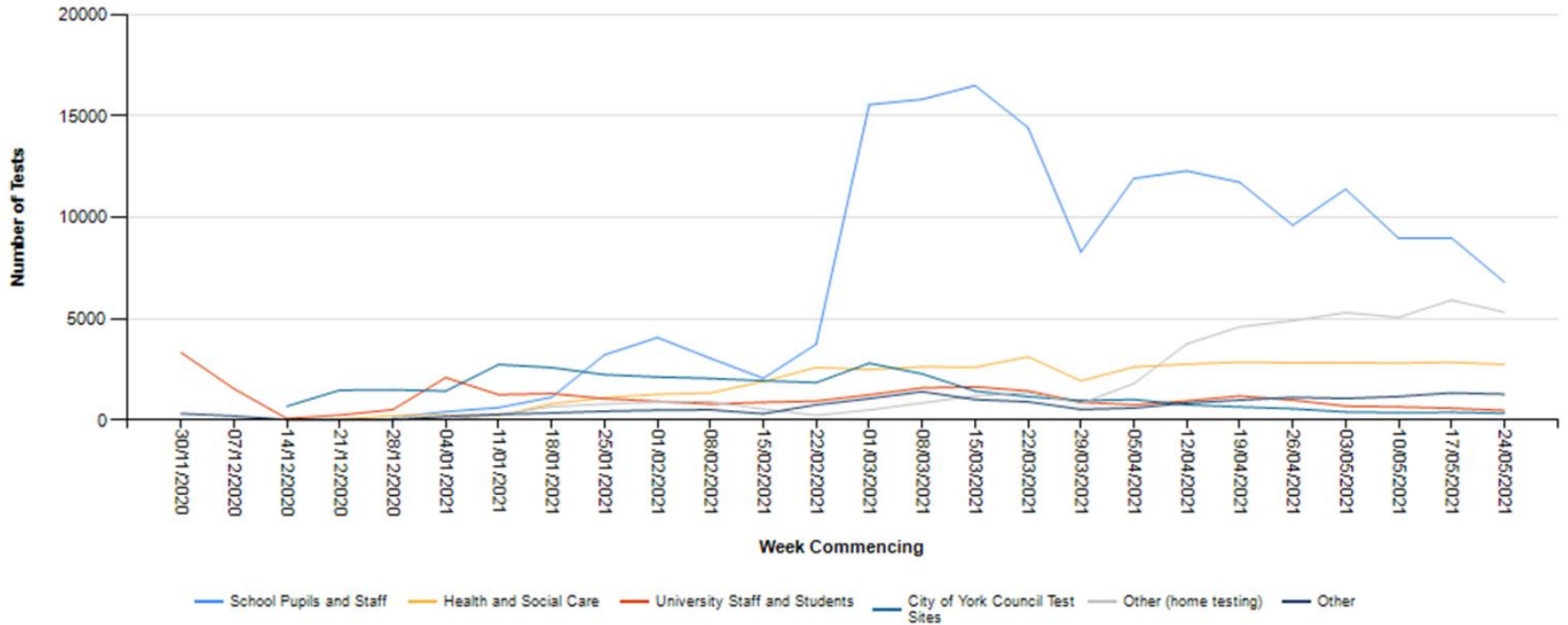

In the latest month for which data is available, **60** cases in York (with a specimen date between 6th May 2021 and 5th June 2021) had been processed in a laboratory which is able to carry out the required sequencing in order to identify Variants of Concern (VOC) or Variants under Investigation (VUI). The breakdown is as follows: VOC B.1.1.7 (Alpha/Kent): **30** confirmed ; VOC B.1.617.2 (Delta /India): **26** provisional; VOC B.1.351 (Beta/South Africa): **2** confirmed ; VUI B.1.617.1 (Kappa/India): **1** confirmed and VOC PI (Gamma – Japan ex Brazil): **1** Provisional.

Local work to increase testing awareness and uptake



- Since 19th May door knocking in areas with higher 20-40 population and lower vaccine uptake:
 - 1,519 properties 1,221 boxes of kits distributed
- Presence at Foss Island Retail Park
 - 90 boxes of kits in 1 day
- Since 19th May providing testing kits at mass vaccination site
 - 1,054 boxes of kits distributed over 8 days

Under-Represented Groups

Underrepresented Groups refers to the population of people who are not proportionally represented or 'hidden' in mass testing. This includes those reluctant or see barriers (real or perceived) to engaging with public services and activities. They share many of the characteristics of PHE's health inclusion groups.

Disproportionately Impacted Groups

Disproportionately Impacted Groups refer to the population of people who are particularly susceptible to the contraction, transmission and impact of the COVID-19 virus. This refocus will largely encompass populations with one or more of these characteristics.

Targeting the low income cohorts working within the retail and hospitality sector - the location is crucial to the re-opening and safety of the City

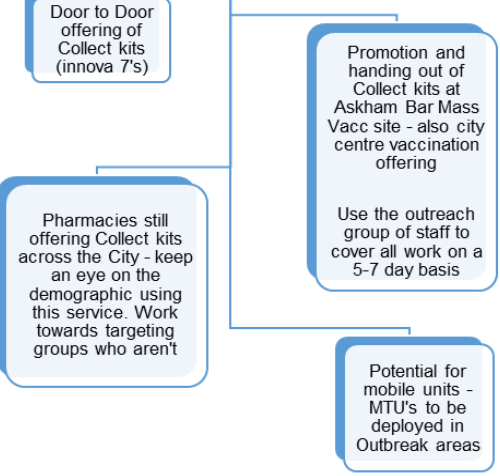
Targeting both the low income households and socio-economic deprivation, along with Ethnic Minority Groups

York St John University - Small assisted testing offer for students who are staying in the City over the summer. Collect model to be incorporated into smaller site



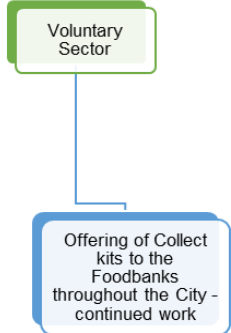
Door to Door offering of Collect kits (innova 7's)

Pharmacies still offering Collect kits across the City - keep an eye on the demographic using this service. Work towards targeting groups who aren't

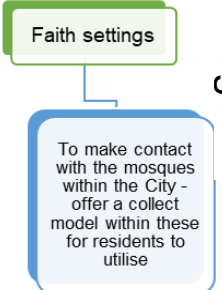
Promotion and handing out of Collect kits at Askham Bar Mass Vacc site - also city centre vaccination offering

Potential for mobile units - MTU's to be deployed in Outbreak areas

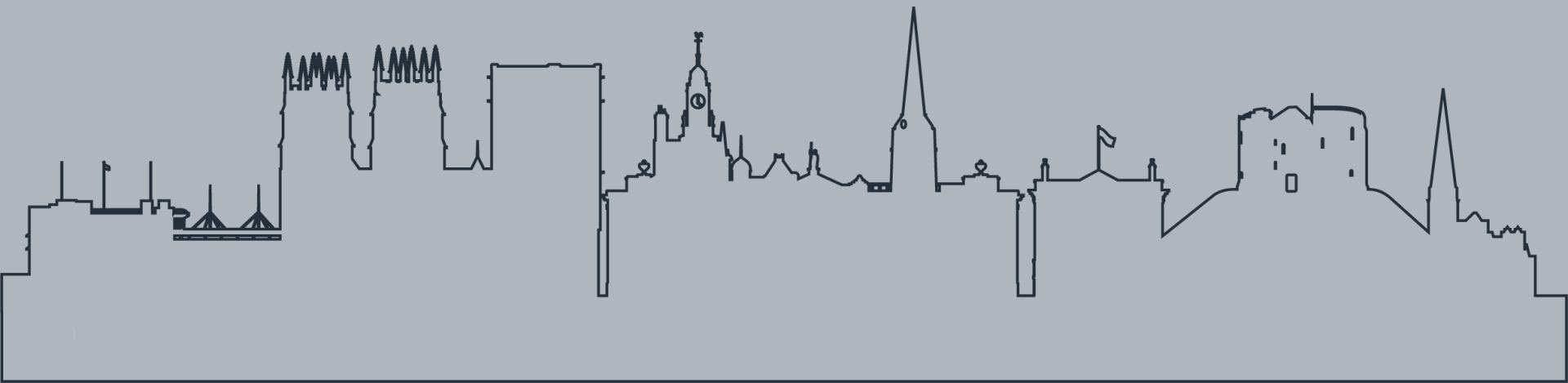
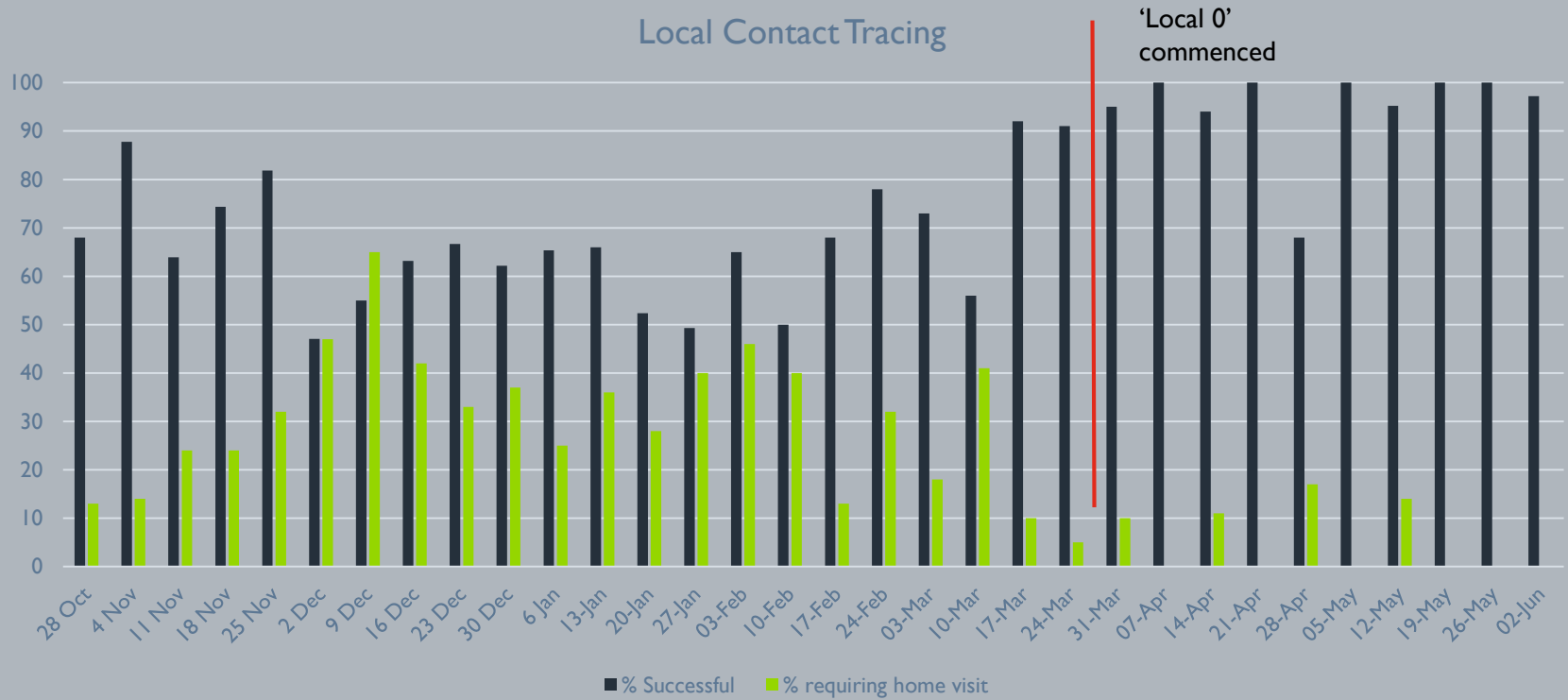

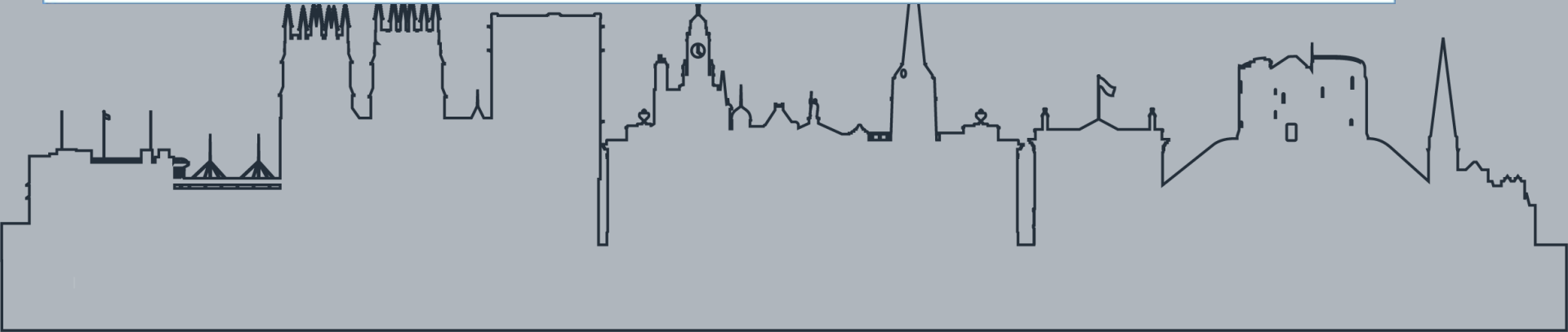
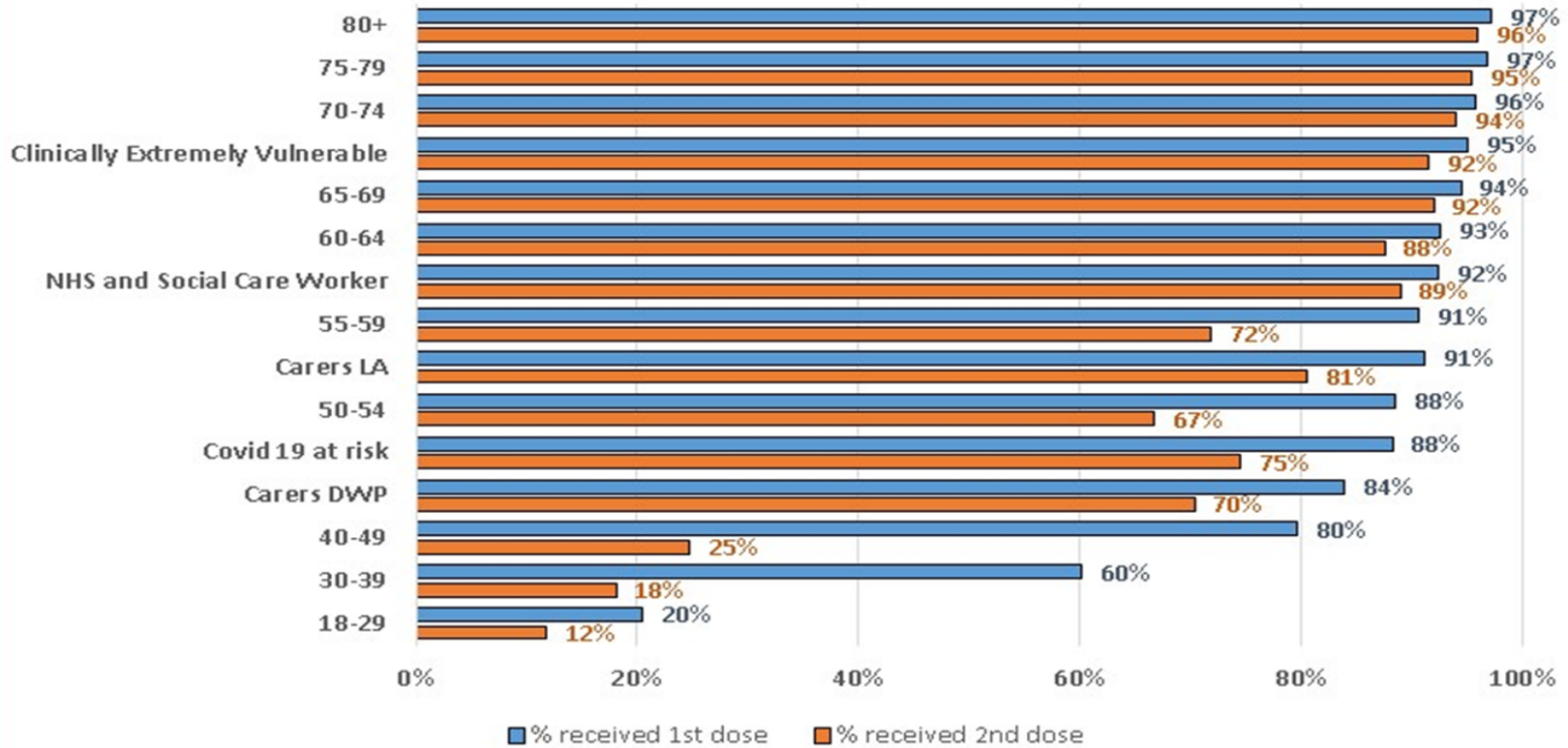


As at 7.6.21 a total of **123,695** CYC residents have had the first dose of the vaccine. This represents **58.7%** of the estimated total population of York and **71.1%** of the estimated adult (18+) population of York.

As at 7.6.21 a total of **83,966** CYC residents have had both doses of the vaccine. This represents **39.9%** of the estimated total population of York and **48.3%** of the estimated adult (18+) population of York.

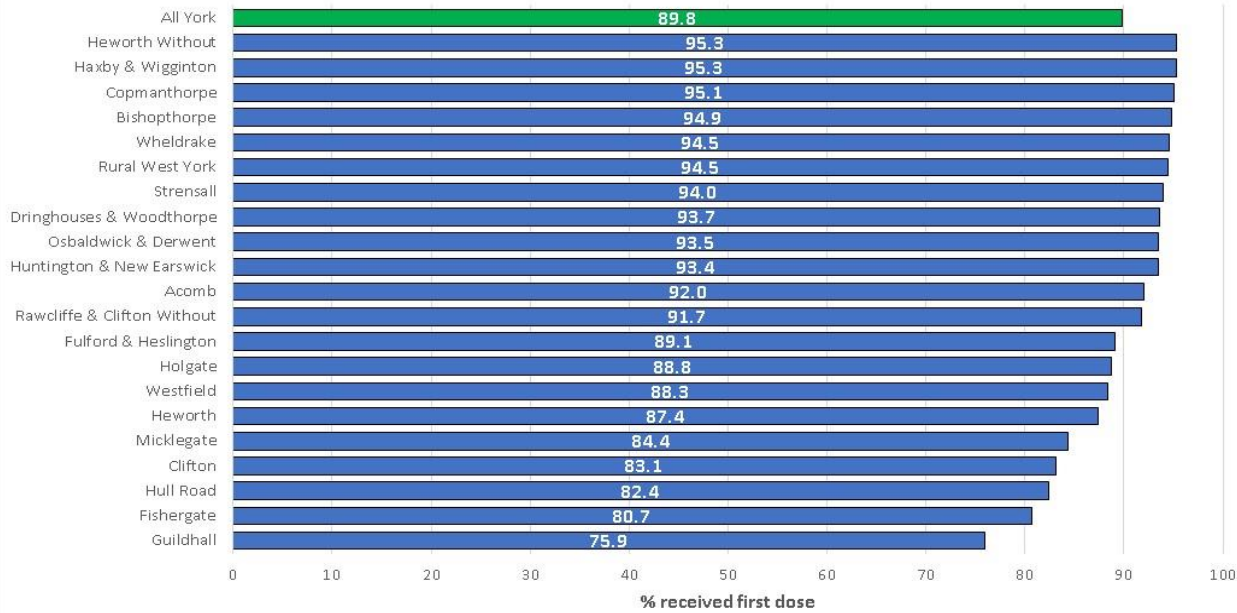


% Receiving the Vaccine by Age / Category - CYC Residents



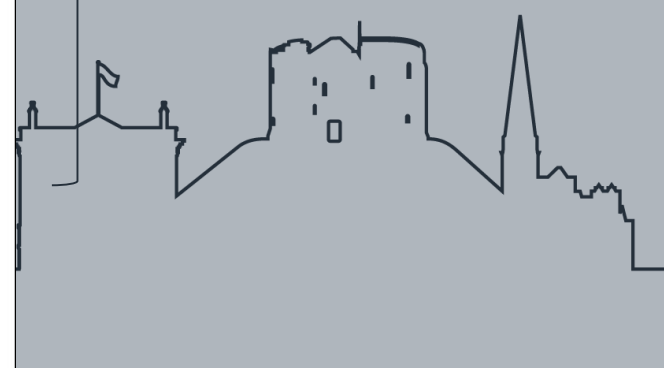
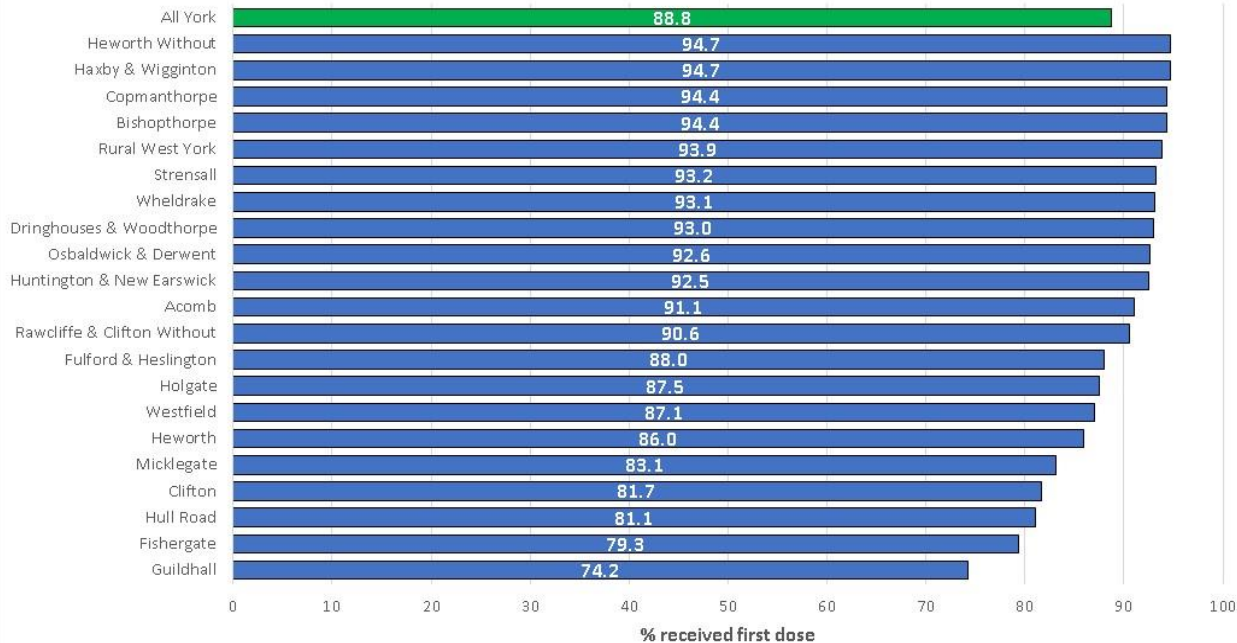
% 40+ ward population received 1st Dose v York Average

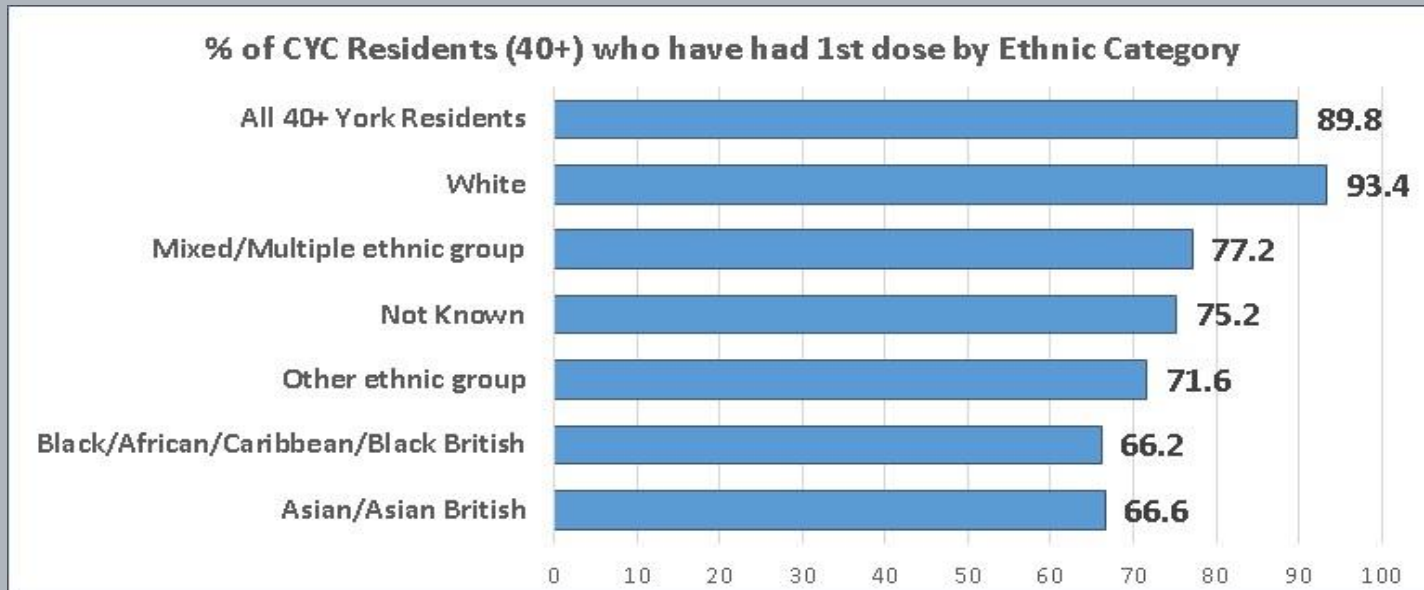
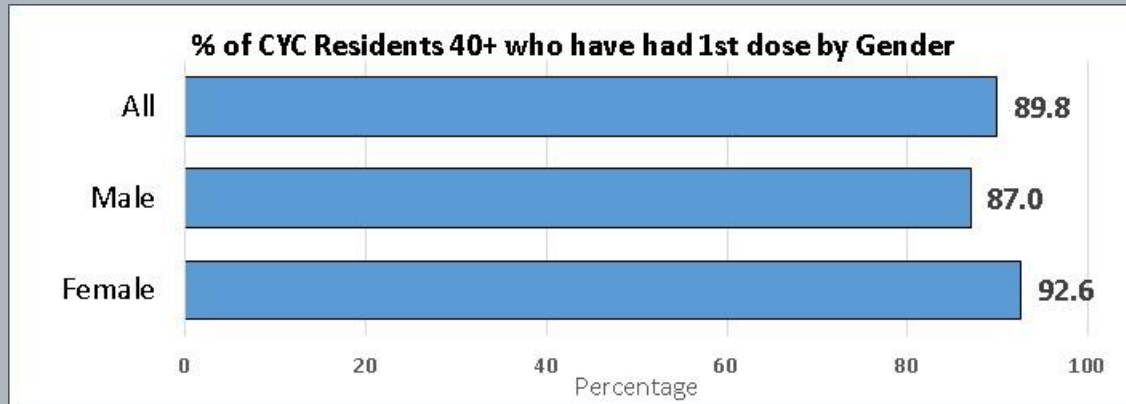


% 40+ ward population received 1st Dose v York Average
