4. VEHICLE IDENTITY AND BRANDING

- RESOLVED:
- (i) That the vehicle livery and branding scheme, as outlined the report and including exceptions, be approved and used for all new vehicles.
 - (ii) That, where possible, practical and affordable, existing vehicles with an expected future life of more than 12 months be aligned with the livery and branding policy.

REASON: To ensure a consistent use of the council's brand and to identify the services it provides.
