



**Transfer of Services between Leeds York Partnership FT and Tees, Esk and
Wear Valleys NHS FT: Reflections, Learning and Assurance**

**Final Report to the Health & Adult Social Care Policy & Scrutiny Committee,
City of York Council Meeting 29th March 2017**

Summary

A lessons learnt review, following the closure of Bootham Park Hospital, York, was presented to the City of York Council, Health and Adult Social Care Policy and Scrutiny Committee on the 25th April 2016. The review and development and monitoring of the resulting action plan have been led by Margaret Kitching, Chief Nurse, NHS England (North).

All actions are now complete with the exception of the following which are on track to deliver by the end of April:
