PUBLIC FOOTPATH ACASTER MALBIS 9 & PUBLIC FOOTPATH BISHOPTHORPE 3 MODIFICATION ORDER 2019

This Order is made by The Council of the City of York under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the authority that the Council of the City of York (Part of the former No 2 Area of the County of the West Riding of Yorkshire) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i). This is due to the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the Map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the Map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Council of the City of York hereby Order that:

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 8 October 2019.

THE COMMON SEAL of THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OR YORK was hereunto affixed

- 2. The Council of the City of York (Part of the former No 2 Area of the County of the West Riding of Yorkshire)
 Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the Map attached to the Order.
- This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Public Footpath Acaster Malbis 9 & Public Footpath Bishopthorpe 3 Modification Order 2019.


