
It would be nice to have more colour, something on the buildings so people say 'have you seen what's happened to Walmgate'.

If someone in a wheelchair needs something from the shop, they have to knock on the door, a member of staff will then ask them what they need and will do the shopping for them.





Improve the thermal comfort of the home, use less energy and reduce bills.




MECHANICAL VENTILATION

BUILDING SERVICES AND ENERGY SYSTEMS


Upgrade energy systems and install renewables (PV solar panels).


