




### **Position in Region**

## Epidemic Curve






Working together to improve and make a difference

The rate of new Covid cases per 100,000 of population for the period 7.5.21 to 13.5.21 for people aged 60+ in York was 4 (2cases). The national and regional averages were 6.3 and 8.3 respectively.











## As at 11.5.21 there were 3 people with Covid in General and Acute beds and 0 in ITU.





In the most recent period (Week 18: 1.5.21 to 7.5.21) **0** Covid-19 deaths were recorded as having occurred for CYC residents. There have been 145 'excess deaths' in York since the start of the 2020 (using the 2015-2019 weekly average number of deaths as the comparator)











### Lateral Flow Tests on York Residents






### Rapid Testing – York Residents
