<b>DATE OF DECISION</b>  Tuesday, 12 July 2013	<b>DECISION MAKER</b> Cabinet Member for Transport, Planning and Sustainability (Councillor Dave Merrett)
<b>DECISION MADE</b>  <b>JOSEPH ROWNTREE SECONDARY SCHOOL – ZEBRA CROSSING AND OFF-ROAD CYCLE LINKS</b>  Cabinet Member agreed to: Approve in principle for the implementation of the proposed highway improvements shown in Annex B, subject to the advertising of the speed limit order. Any objections to the order would be brought back to an Officer in Consultation meeting for a decision on the way forward. If there are no objections, approval is granted to implement the scheme.	
<b>REASONS FOR THE DECISION</b> Reason: To improve conditions for pedestrians and cyclists who live sought of the school.
