Determination of a Section 18(3) (a) Application for a premises licence in respect of Clifton Bridge Hotel, 23 Water End, Clifton, York YO30 6LL (CYC-070384)

Meeting reconvened remotely in private session at 12:35 pm on 23 May 2022.

PRESENT: Councillors Melly (Chair), Galvin and Hook

The Sub-Committee resolved to approve Option 2 and grant the licence with modified and additional conditions imposed by the Sub-Committee, as set out below:

Activity	Timings
Supply of alcohol – on the premises	Monday to Sunday 12:00 – 23:00
Opening hours	Monday to Sunday 12:00 – 23:00

The modified conditions are as follows (amendments in italics):

- 1. The PLH/DPS will prominently display notices which inform customers that open bottles or glasses may not be taken off the premises, *or into the car park*.
- Appropriate background checks on all potential staff will be carried out before offering them employment. The Licensee will report any child related concerns to the police they have about potential staff, existing staff and customers.

The additional conditions are as follows:

1. The sale of alcohol shall only be by waiter/waitress service to seated customers.

2. No more than 43 covers to be provided inside the premises for customers dining, and no more than 20 covers to be provided outside the premises for customers dining.

No conditions have been removed from the operating schedule submitted by the Applicant.

The full reasons for the Sub-Committee's decision will be included in the detailed Decision Letter which will be provided to the Applicant and Representors in due course.

There is a right of appeal for the Applicant and the Representors to the Magistrates' Court against this decision. Any appeal to the Magistrates Court must be made within 21 days of receipt of the Decision Letter and sent to the following address:
