

ARTICLE 10 - REGULATORY AND OTHER COMMITTEES

1 Regulatory and Other Committees

1.1 The Council will appoint the Committees set out in Part 3C of this Constitution to discharge the functions of those Committees as set out in Part 3C.

1.2 In making appointments to non-Executive bodies the Council will consult with and will consider the interests of Members who do not form part of a political group.

2 Working Groups

2.1 The Council, the Executive or any Committee may establish Working Groups on an ad hoc basis.

2.2 Working Groups do not legally have any power to take decisions and act in an advisory capacity to decision making bodies.

2.3 The membership of Working Groups does not have to be constituted on a politically proportionate basis.

3 Task groups

3.1 The scrutiny committees may establish task groups formed within the membership of an individual scrutiny committee to undertake a specific scrutiny review in accordance with the powers conferred by section 21 of the Local Government Act 2000.
