### **Police Update**

Apologies that no one from the team can attend as the team are on day shift with 'Crucial crew' commitments and July 4<sup>th</sup> duties at Menwith Hill.

As of 4<sup>th</sup> June 2012 the updated Safer Neighbourhood team for Derwent, Osbaldwick and Heworth Without is as follows –

Crimes in the Ward over the past 3 months – April/ May /June.

Osbaldwick – 45 crimes (includes shop theft at B&Q and fraud at BP Hull road, x 9) – (Previous year 34 crimes).

Derwent – 18 crimes (previous year 16 crimes)

Heworth Without – 17 crimes ( previous year 22 crimes).

The team have daily taskings which are targeting local criminals and anti social behaviour (ASB) hotspots. These targets are visited to disrupt their behaviour and the ASB areas are patrolled as part of the daily patrols plans.

The PCSO ASB patrol car is out on a daily basis on local patrols and answers calls of ASB in the area.

The team also have 'weekly important goals' focusing on targeting and reducing crime in the area and the focus for July 2012 is on vehicle crime (Op Buckaroo).

There are 4 active problem solving plans running at the moment in the area which relate to ASB (Op Brink) , Metal theft (Op Tornado), Vehicle crime (Op Buckaroo), Burglary (Op Haven..

We are still running a selection of surgeries throughout the month and if you have any queries you are more than welcome to attend these. A full list can be found on the NYP internet site or on the notice boards within the Wards. Cycle marking (Op Spoke) can be requested from your local PCSO.

We encourage local Residents to please report incidents of ASB or any criminal activity to the local team so they can stay up to date of area incidents and we can support the local community and gather information related to issues on our area.
