### **Ward budget update**

With the use of a Power Point presentation (see copy attached) Ward Councillors provided an update on projects funded this year and the remaining amount of ward budget. A list of potential schemes that the Ward Team plans to commission was presented and comments/suggestions were invited.

A comment was raised that the Vehicle Activated Sign may not totally alleviate the speeding issue on Chaloner's Road and a suggestion was offered to resurface parts of Lomond Ginnel instead of using the fund for repainting of the missing centre line and symbols. This will be investigated further.

### **Update on play consultation**

Councillor Fenton spoke about the recent play consultation and the next steps in the process, which will include the establishment of a panel to consider city wide feedback and make recommendations on allocation of funds.

### **Review of ward priorities**

Ward Councillors outlined current ward priorities and invited residents to take part in discussion about proposed priorities for the year ahead.
