

DECISION MADE <u>EU Service Directive – Tacit Authorisation</u> The purpose of this report is to advise the Cabinet Members of the Council's obligation to comply with the EU Service Directive (the Directive), in relation to the requirements of tacit authorisation. The Cabinet Members are asked to agree the list of permissions, licences and consents where tacit authorisations should be disappplied.	
REASONS FOR THE DECISION The Directive assumes that all permissions, licenses and consents affected will have a pre-published determination period, where an application is not determined within this timeframe it is granted by default. This is known as 'tacit authorisation'. There is a mechanism whereby a permission, licence or consent can have 'tacit authorisation' disappplied if there is an overriding reason to do so in the public interest.	
ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED To amend the list of permission, licences and consents where tacit authorisations should be disappplied.
