4. FOOD SERVICE PLAN 2019-2020

Resolved: That the food service plan be approved.

Resolved:

- (i) That all the reviews be undertaken as outlined in the options:
 - Option 1 – Review the following areas of the street cleansing service.
 - Option 2 – Review and amend the contract
 - Option 3 – Use of third party resources
 - Option 4 – Alternatives to Glyphosate
- (ii) That Bishophill and one other area of York be inspected by officers and the Executive Member for Environment and Climate Change.

(iii) That officers be requested to consider the future officer monitoring arrangements of the contract.
