1. Open top bus tour around the Ward.

Approximately 28 residents attended the ward committee event which travelled a route around Holgate Ward on an open top bus.

Residents spoke to councillors, Neighbourhood Management and Street Environment regarding issues with their alleyways, especially Walworth Street North, Bright Street and Kingslands. Issues such as weed killing, dog fouling and rubbish were discussed.

A kebab shop / takeaway was discussed regarding use of domestic bins for commercial use.

Other residents discussed security and burglaries and street lights on Lindsay Avenue with councillors, Street Environment and the Police. Also overgrown trees were mentioned, overhanging and blocking light at the back of Lindsey Avenue.
