As you are aware there has been an ongoing situation with regards to planning permission at the foot clinic at 289 Hull road, we have no axe to grind with the proprietors of this business however the reverse of that cannot be said, I am aware of some unsavoury incidents and threats to local residents with regards to the ongoing parking issues by staff and visitors to this business.

Most of the residents of this Street are very elderly and have lived here for many years, they have lived here in relative harmony with the predecessor of this property, this is now not the case and any suggestion that friendships exist with the proprietors is untrue as there have been several incidents that have soured any potential relationships some of this constitutes bullying and harassment which is not acceptable. We fully supported the erection of the perimeter fencing and was fully consulted on its installation, we also added our names to a petition requesting this fencing.

We have recently sustained damage to our property in the form of damage to a brick gate post although there were no witnesses to which vehicle caused the damage at the time of the incident the only visitors to the street would have been residents and visitors to the foot clinic. No one came forward to own up to causing this damage or offer a apology, therefore we will have to foot the bill which could run into hundreds of pounds. Just out of interest the colour of the car was light blue metallic as paint was retrieved from the gate post, no residents of the street have a car this colour and they would also have had the decency to speak to us.

We reaffirm our support of Cllr Waters.

Dear Rachel,


From our knowledge of Mr Mark Warters, he has always been friendly, and helpful. Any decisions made, have been made after consulting with us and agreeing what would happen.

Here is my witness statement for the hearing tomorrow:

To the members of the hearing panel,

Last year I was contacted in November by the owner of the Foot Clinic on Hull Road which is in my Ward. They were claiming ownership of the land opposite their property, and had been told that it belonged to CYC. Having confirmed with them that this land was in fact owned by them, they then asked for my assistance in applying to turn this land into a carpark for their business. After several attempts to help them, this issue became bogged down in West Offices. I had a telephone conversation with Mr & Mrs Moore on the 25<sup>th</sup> January which was overheard by my wife. In that conversation Mr Moore spoke down to me and indicated that I had done nothing to help. This comment caused me some offence, and as my wife heard it, it also caused her some

distress. I have been trying very hard to help this couple, and since my help was not recognised, I have withdrawn from the process.
