5. APPOINTMENT OF LOCAL AUTHORITY (LA) SCHOOL GOVERNORS

RESOLVED: That the appointment and re-appointment of Local Authority Governors, as proposed in Annex 1 of the report, be approved.¹

REASON: To ensure that local authority places on school governing bodies continue to be effectively filled.

6. YORK YOUTH COMMUNITY ACTION PILOT

RESOLVED: (i) That the process underway for local implementation of the Youth Community Action Grant Fund be noted.

(ii) That funding for the list of projects recommended by the York Youth Community Action Assessment Panel (detailed in Annex 1 of the report) be approved, with officers being granted a degree of discretion at the margins (within normal delegation limits) in relation to their detailed discussions with individual applicants¹.

(iii) That a summary of the evaluation of the project be presented to the Executive Member when it becomes available next year².

REASONS: (i) The assessment process has been rigorous and effective.

(ii) The projects offer a great opportunity for City of

York Council to work with the voluntary groups of York and provide the city's 14-16 year olds with a range of opportunities that would otherwise have been unavailable to them.
