# Item3 Safer Neighbourhood Policing Team Update

Apologies that no one from the team can attend.

As of 4<sup>th</sup> June 2012 the updated Safer Neighbourhood team for Huntington and New Earswick is as follows –

Inspector Jo Brooksbank, Sgt 1343 Donna Musgrove, PC 1796 Alex Dobson - Beat Manager, PCSO 6461 Fiona Nevens – Huntington south,

PCSO 6613 Richard Parry – New Earswick,

PCSO 3534 John Lemboli – Huntington north,

PCSO 6457 Marie Hampshire – Huntington south.

Crime Figures for April, May and June so far – crime is down by 11.4% in the area since April.

The team have daily taskings which are targeting local criminals and anti social behaviour (ASB) hotspots. These people are visited to disrupt their behaviour and the ASB areas are patrolled as part of the daily patrols plans.

The PCSO ASB patrol car is out on a daily basis on local patrols and answers calls of ASB in the area.

There are 3 active problem solving plans running at the moment in the area which relate to ASB (Op Brink), Metal theft (Op Tornado) and Retail crime (Op Briefcase).

Neighbourhood Watch (NW) week will run from 16<sup>th</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> June 2012 and the local team are running a NW week event on 20<sup>th</sup> June in the Huntington area which will involve the team being out in the area posting letters to local addresses making people aware of NW and also trying to get people involved in NW

Cycle marking dates (Op Spoke) – 21/07/12 10am -12 noon – New Earswick shops, Hawthorne Terrace and 21/07/12 - 12:30 – 14:30 at Monks Cross retail park.

We encourage local Residents to please report incidents of ASB or any criminal activity to the police so that team stay up to date of area
