#### **Lidgett Grove Methodist Church**

Grant to upgrade the community cafe/kitchen with a new dishwasher fridge and freezer, cooker extension to the kitchen, additional chairs and improve the external signage.(£8,080)

#### Friends of Carr School

Grant to produce a 'Day in the life' film to commemorate the old school site. (£2,000)

#### **Fishponds Wood**

Commission tree work on the Fishponds Wood site. (£1,150)

#### Friends of Fishponds Wood

Grant for and PLI cover for the group and purchase of bat boxes and costs associated with chipping tree logs and branches (£340)

#### Trees planting across the ward

Commission planting trees at various locations across the ward. £7,200 dedicated to pay for 40 tree saplings, tree guards, planting by the contractor and watering visits.





#### **Arty Farty Stuff CIC Legacy project**

Grant to Arty Farty Stuff Community Interest Company towards the Legacy project to undertake intergenerational story share of Acomb. (£3,750)

#### **Active 8 Learning**

Grant to provide a range of craft and skill workshops for elderly people to learn new skills. (£1,500)

#### **Lidgett Grove Methodist Church**

Grant to fund a community farm project as part of an extended Community Café during Easter. (£540)

#### **Lidgett Grove Methodist Church**

Grant towards re-launch of the community garden. (£1,212)

#### **Craft and Chat**

Grant to Craft and Chat group based at the Lidgett Grove Church towards craft materials and equipment. (£628)

#### **Acomb Fun Run**

Funding towards publicity materials and other costs associated with running of the Acomb Fun Run. (£500)

#### Sports activities provision

Commission Total Sports and York City Football Club Foundation to provide sports activities for young people in the ward over the summer 2017. (£3,155)

### 2017/18 Ward budget timetable

Community and voluntary groups are invited to submit bids for funding for schemes which support the delivery of our Ward Priorities - Reducing social isolation; Increasing facilities and activities for young people; A cleaner, greener ward; Improving health and wellbeing; Increased community involvement.

The window for applications is open until 30 April 2017.
Depending on the availability of funding a second round for applications will be open later in the year

### 2017/18 Ward budget allocation

- Ward general/revenue budget: £23,673 (excluding carry forward amount from year 2016-17 which is yet to be confirmed).
- Ward highways/capital budget: £11,280 (plus carry forward of £22,560 from years 2015-16 and 2016-17).
