- For 2019 to 2020 the ward revenue budget allocation is £24,060, plus carry over from the last financial year of just under £12,700 (£36,760 total).
- Community groups and voluntary organisations based in the ward can now apply for grants of up to £500 towards projects which will help to address ward priorities. Full applications should be received no later than Friday 19th July.


- The current ward priorities against which grant applications will be assessed are:
- •improve the local environment and take pride in Westfield
- reduce isolation
- improve activities for young people

- ➤ We have used £1,200 from the 2019-20 budget to commission the York City Knights Foundation and the York City Football Club Foundation to deliver free to access sports activities provision for young people from the area over the summer holidays 2019.
- This will include mobile skatepark, multisport inflatable arena and football activity sessions.

- ➤ We have dedicated £2,500 from the 2019-20 budget towards provision of a series of vehicle collecting metal, wood, plastic and general waste visits.
- Vehicles will be visiting locations across the ward in September 2019.

Ward Capital and Housing Environment Improvement Programme

- The ward also has an allocation of capital budget that can be utilised for improvements to the local highways infrastructure. The amount allocated for 2019 to 2020 is £17,181.
- ➤ HEIP allocation is £132,000 over the next 4 years (April 2019 to March 2023) and is intended for delivery of improvements that Council tenants have identified as important.
- To deliver bigger schemes which have more impact and to achieve better value for money in mixed tenure areas we can look at using both ward capital and the HEIP pots.
