Funds for 2019/20

- Ward revenue budget of £35,545
- £2,230 remains unspent, to be carried forward
- Schemes supported included:
 - Grants to local groups
 - Tree planting
 - Youth activities
 - Community noticeboards

Capital and HEIP funds 2019 - 2023

- £125,693 capital and £30,000 HEIP (for benefit of CYC tenants)
- Awaiting quotes for schemes including:
 - New streetlights
 - Resurfacing potholed footpaths
 - Parking bays / verge protection
 - Cycle hoops
 - Storage units for CYC flats

Funds for 2020/21

- Ward revenue budget of £38,297 to be spent in support of our ward priorities:
- o improving the local environment
- increasing community involvement
- improving access to services and support
- o promoting community safety

Funds for 2020/21

- Community groups can bid for funds
- Early ideas for schemes to commission:
 - More youth provision, including open access youth club
 - Leeside playground improvements
 - More tree planting
 - Support for a possible 'Community Hub'
