Four-year capital / HEIP budget

- Delays in delivery of some schemes, such as refreshing cycle path markings, installing new streetlights, renewing signage on Hob Moor, zebra crossing upgrades and installing bollards to protect pedestrians on Moorcroft Road
- Locations identified for additional cycle hoops to be installed on Tadcaster Road
- Snicket / path resurfacing projects completed
- Quotes obtained for some schemes such as Bracken Road verge reinforcement and smallscale resurfacing work
- Awaiting outcome of CYC 'barrier review' and possible call on ward capital funding
- HEIP budget fully committed
