Cllr Smalley advised that the area is in the 2023 Highways review for possible double yellow lines and due to be looked at in October 2023. Cllr Rawlings advised that a licence has been granted for the skip and it is being actively used and emptied. Cllr Wann advised that hedges need to be reported to CYC on a case-by-case basis.
