

Heworth Without Ward

K1	Location: Bramley Garth/ Stray Road
Nature of problem and requested solution A resident has raised an issue of parked vehicles on Stray Road preventing visibility of vehicles exiting Bramley Garth. Resident has also stated that vehicles parking opposite the junction of Bramley Garth are leading to oncoming vehicles approaching each other in the middle of the carriageway.	
Background information There is a bend to the road north of the junction that restricts visibility when stationary at the junction. All residential properties opposite the junction have off-street parking for a minimum of two vehicles.	
Recommendation To implement no waiting at any time restriction on Stray Road and to the junction of Bramley Garth to improve visibility and the free flow of traffic.
