Grant to pay for replacement of the rotary swing at the play
park. (£1560)

street sign. (£500)

Osboldwick Parish Council

Grant to pay for replacement / improvements to bollards and fencing on the Leyes in Osboldwick. (£1600)

Dunnington Playing Fields Association

Grant to pay for installation of CCTV cameras around play park and playing field. (£7300)

Dunnington Cricket Club

Grant to pay for extension of either side of the existing cricket square to enable two simultaneous junior games to be played at the same time. (£1245)

Planned improvements

Improvements to St Thomas Close, Osbaldwick

To replace the narrow strips of verge with cobbles inlaid into concrete. The flags will remain in place, the triangular pieces of verge at the entrance to the Close will remain and a tree will be planted on one side to match the other side. Cast Iron bollards will be placed on both corners (approx £4900).
