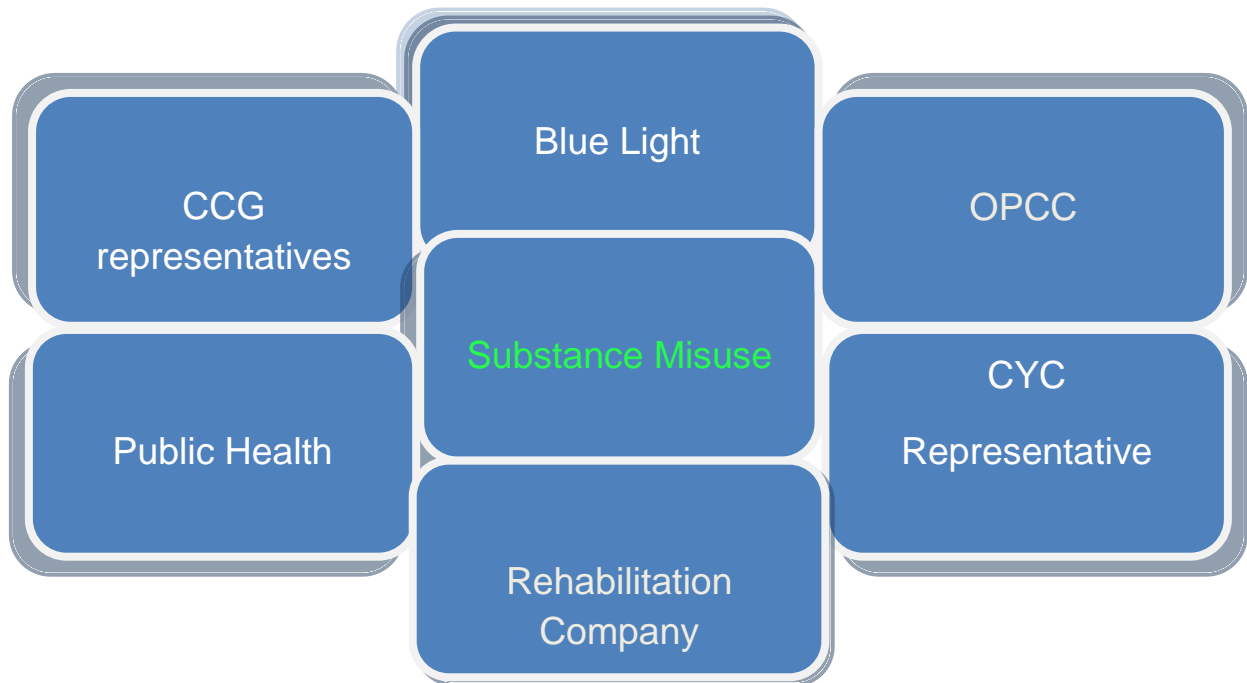


York Substance Misuse Commissioning Strategy Board
