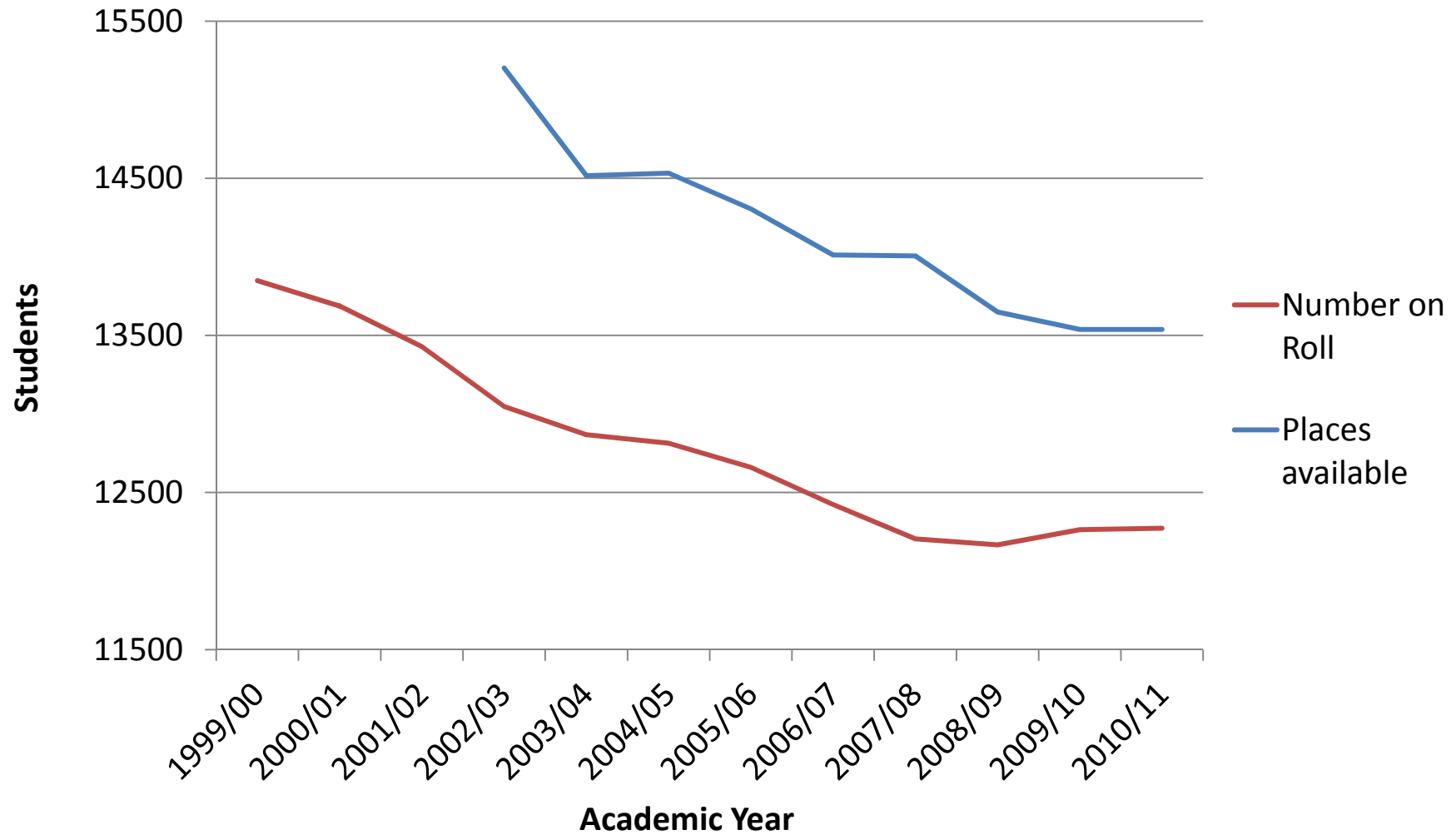

Primary school places available vs Number on Roll

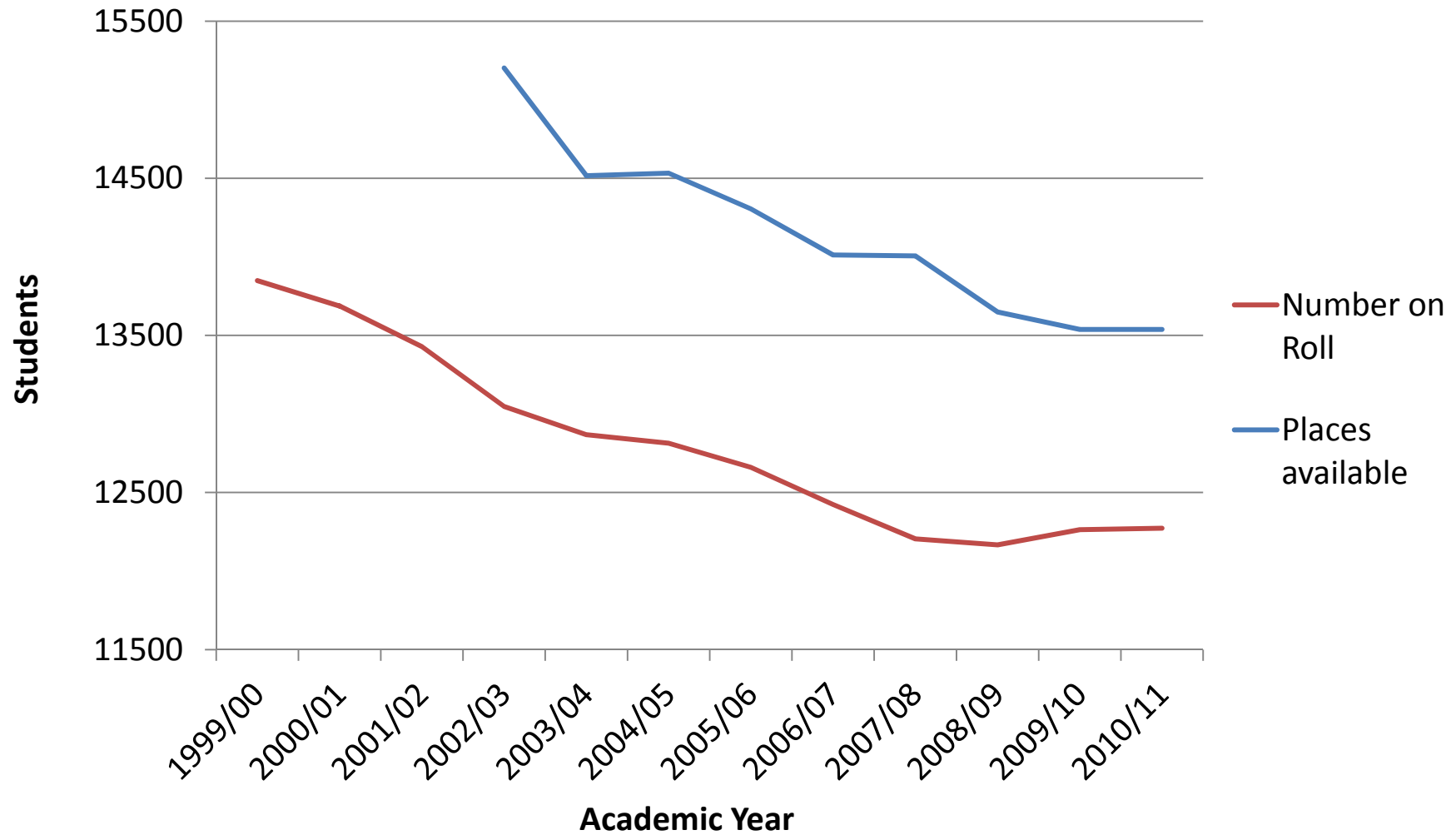

Ways to reduce capacity

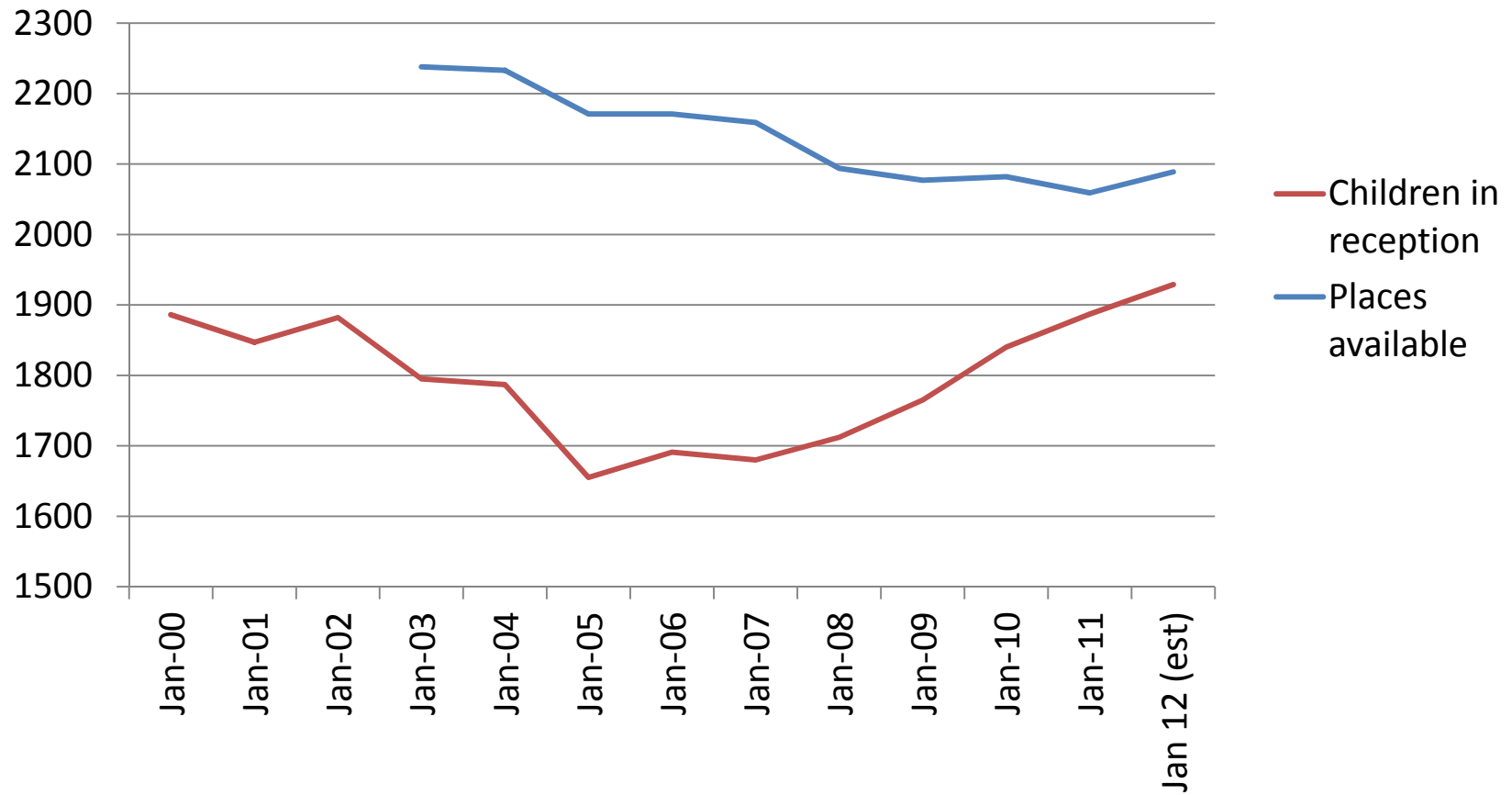
- Alternative use of classroom spaces

Primary school places available vs Number on Roll



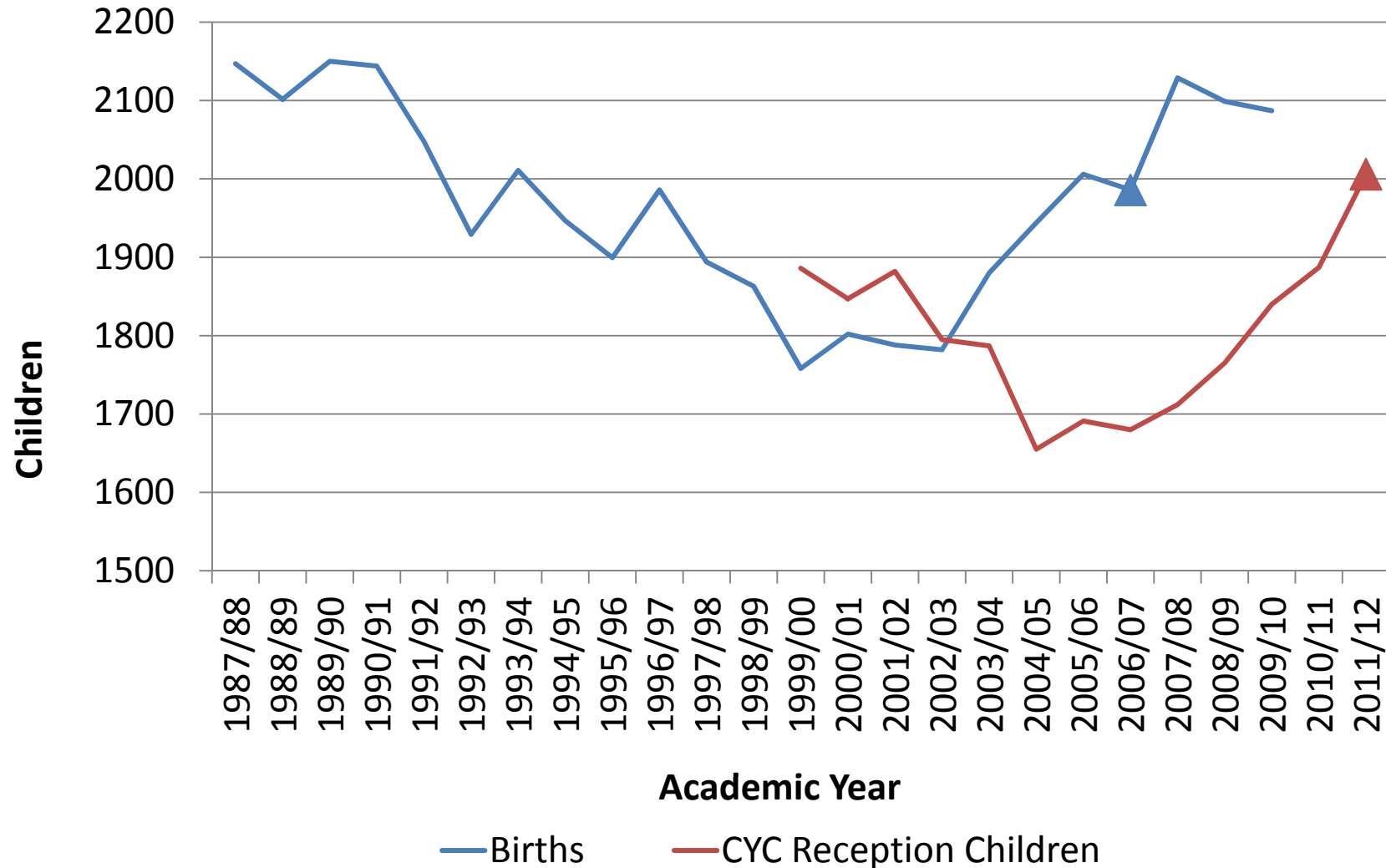

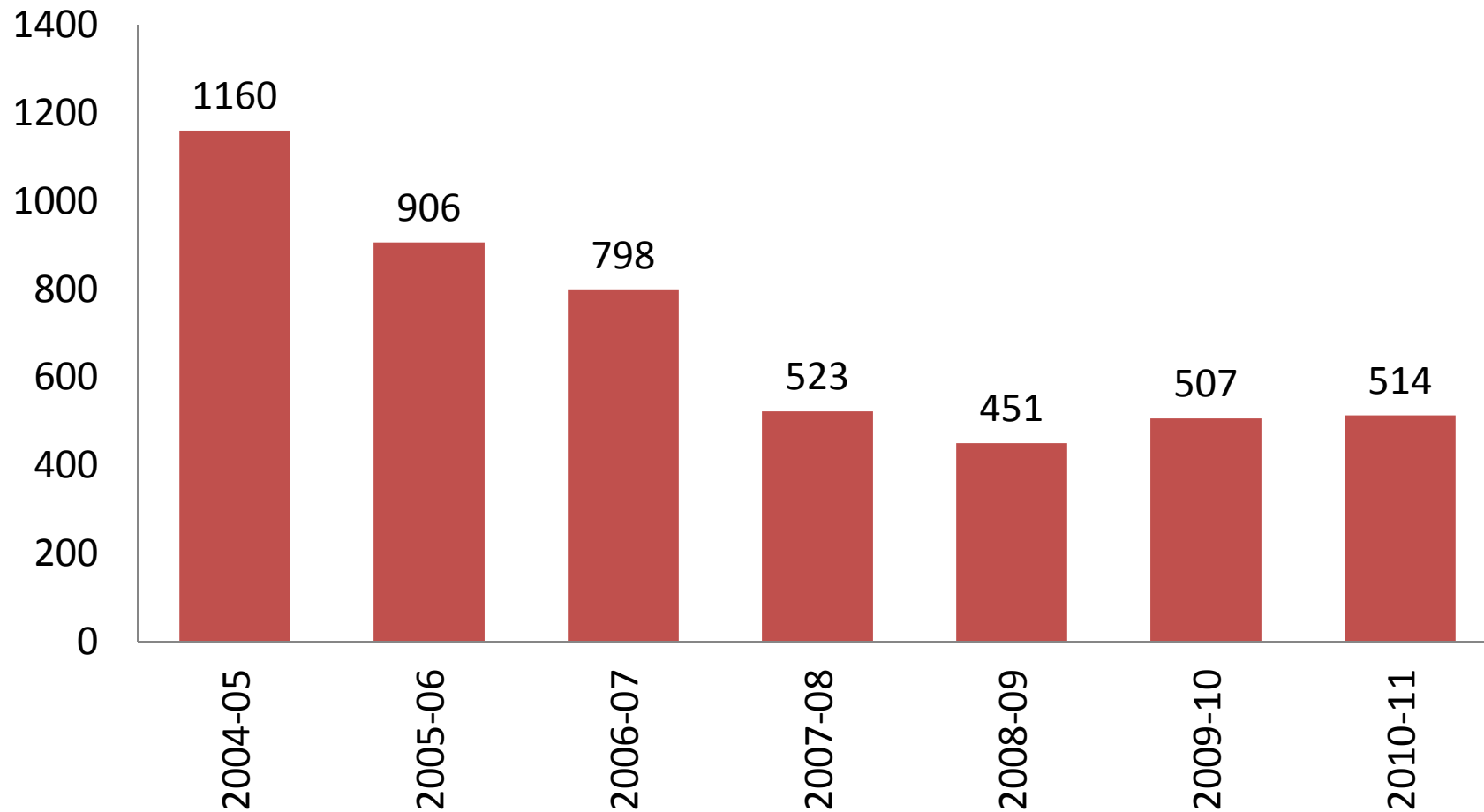

Cause 1: rising births

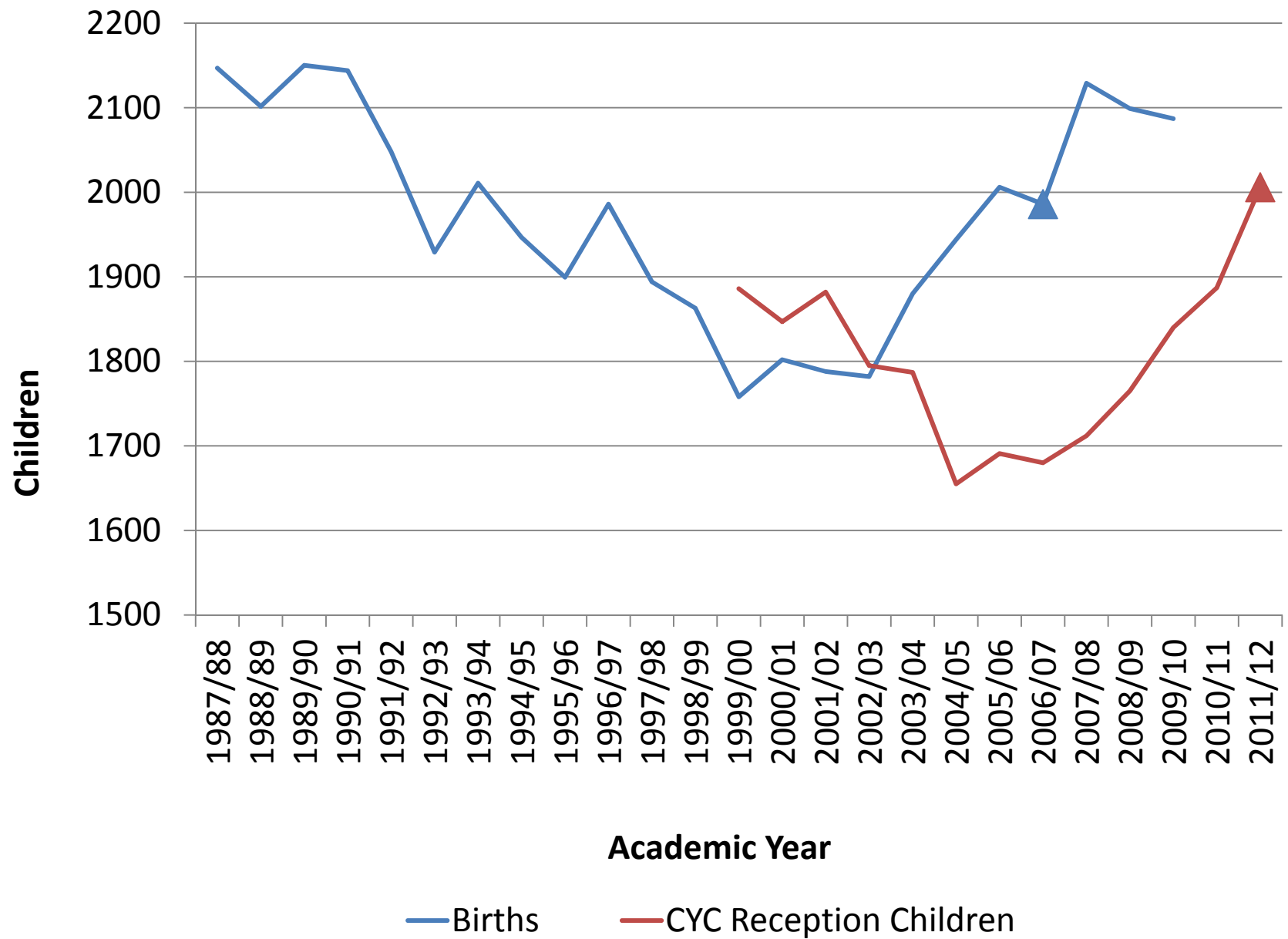

Cause 2: New housing completions

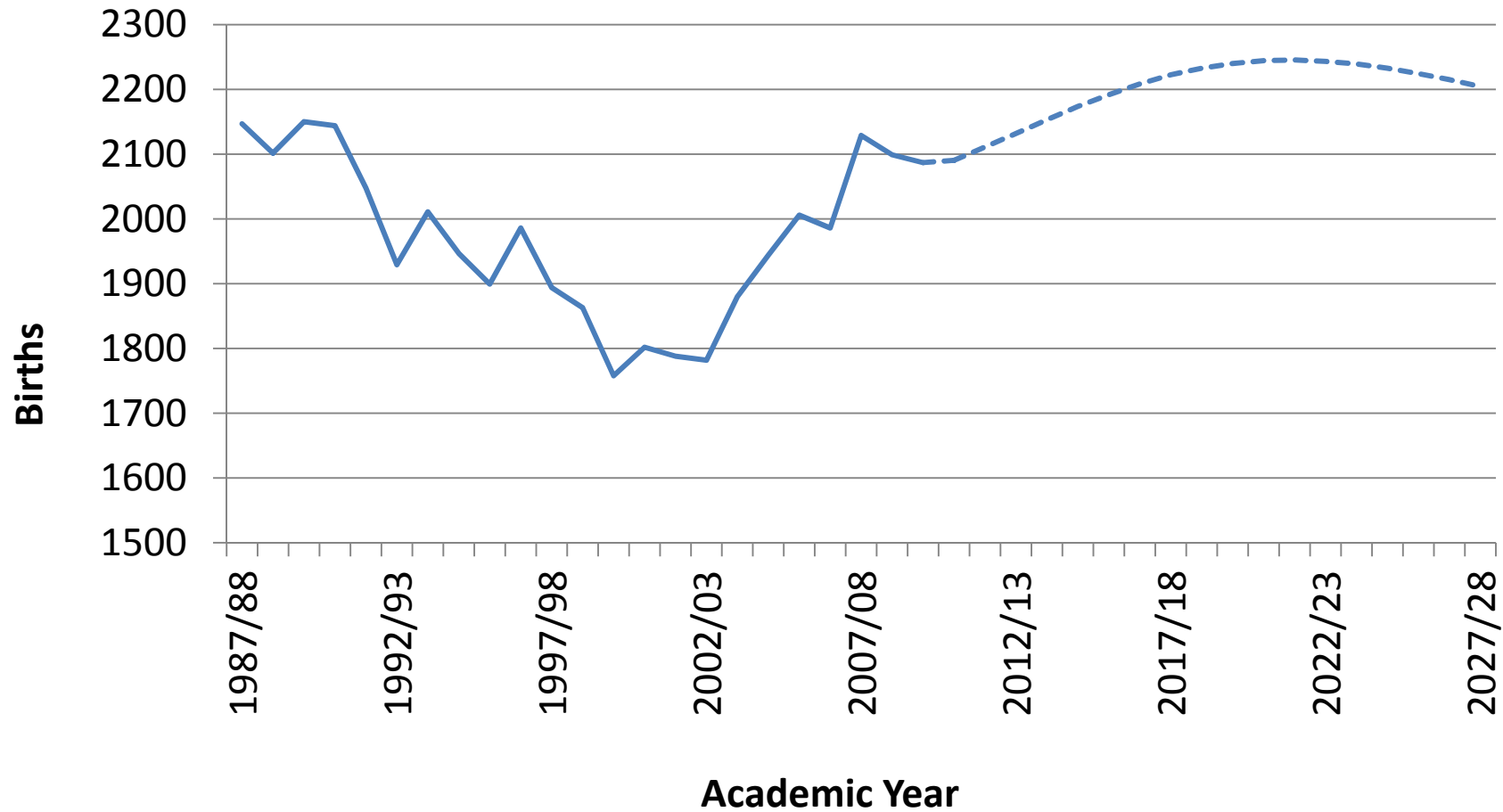

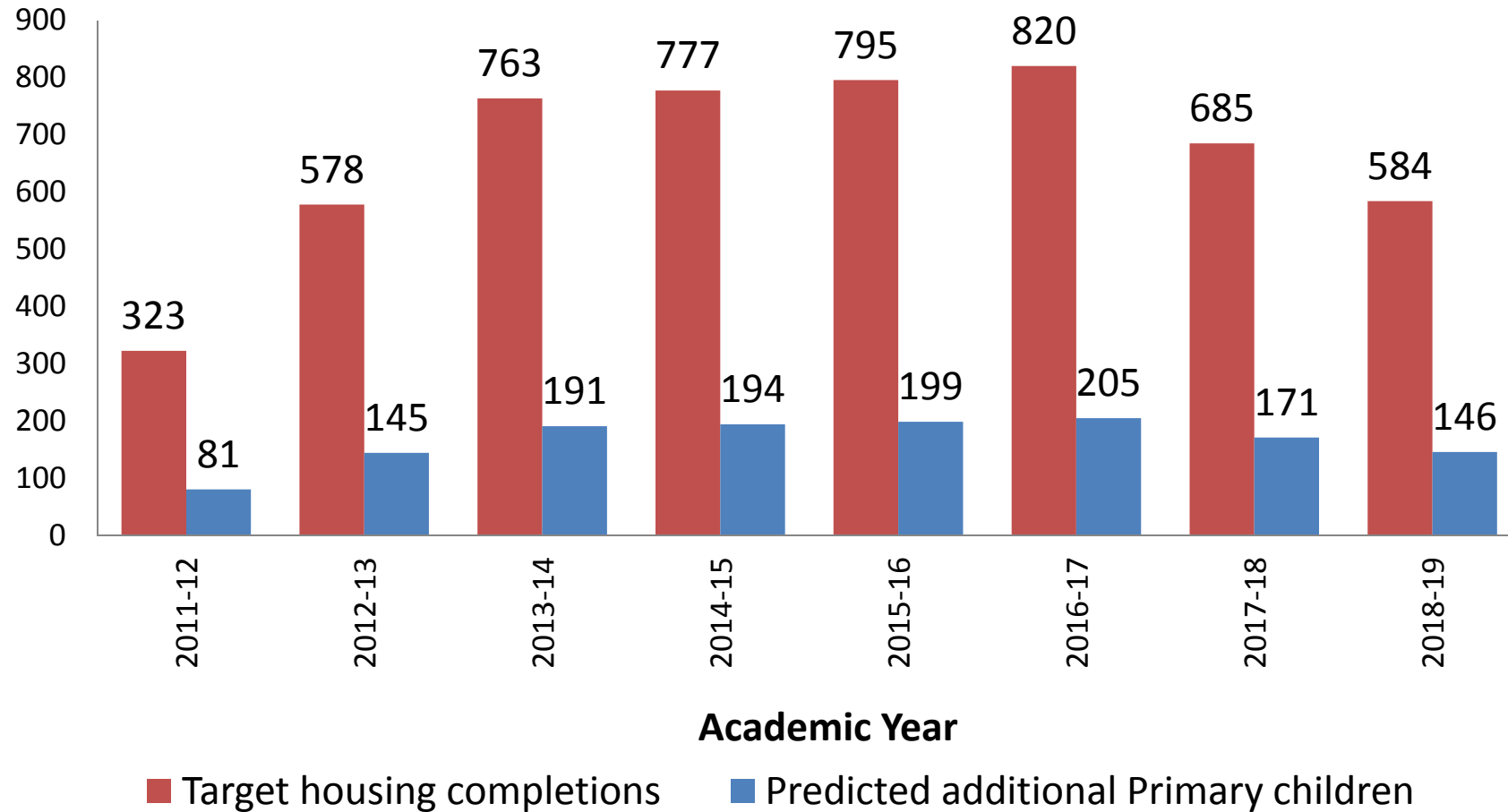

THE FUTURE: Birth rate



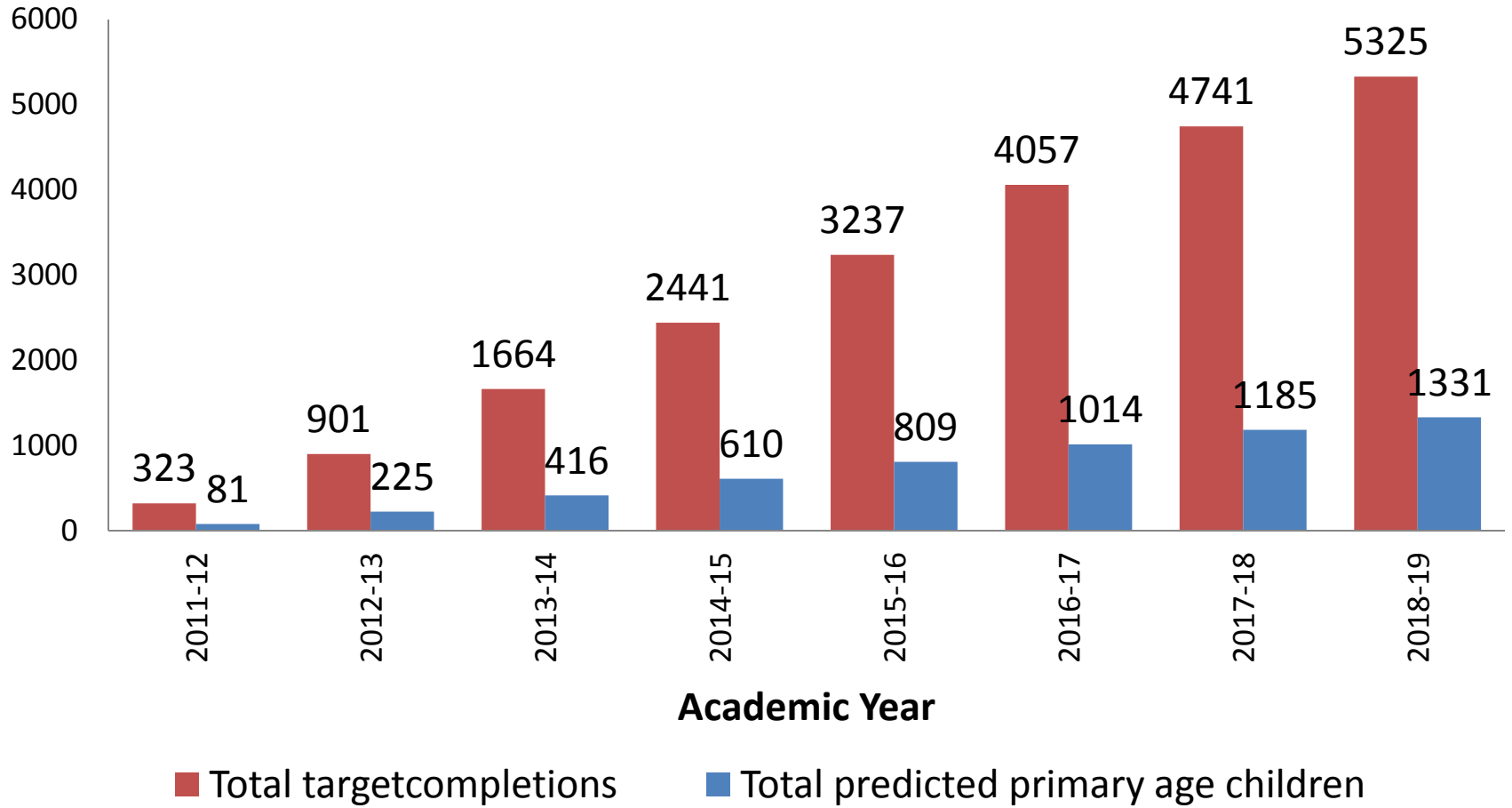

THE FUTURE: proposed new housing



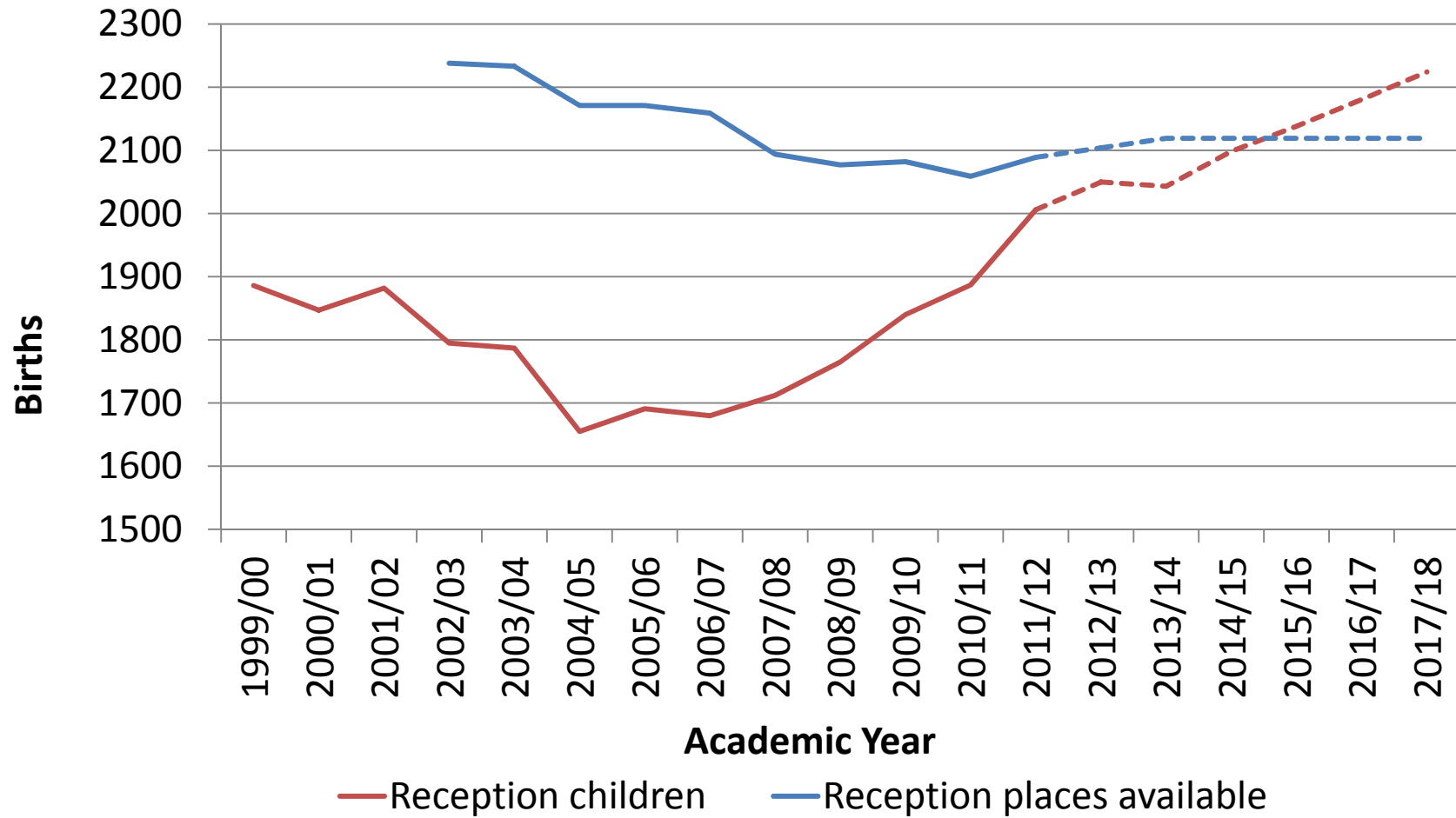

THE FUTURE: Proposed housing (cumulative impact)

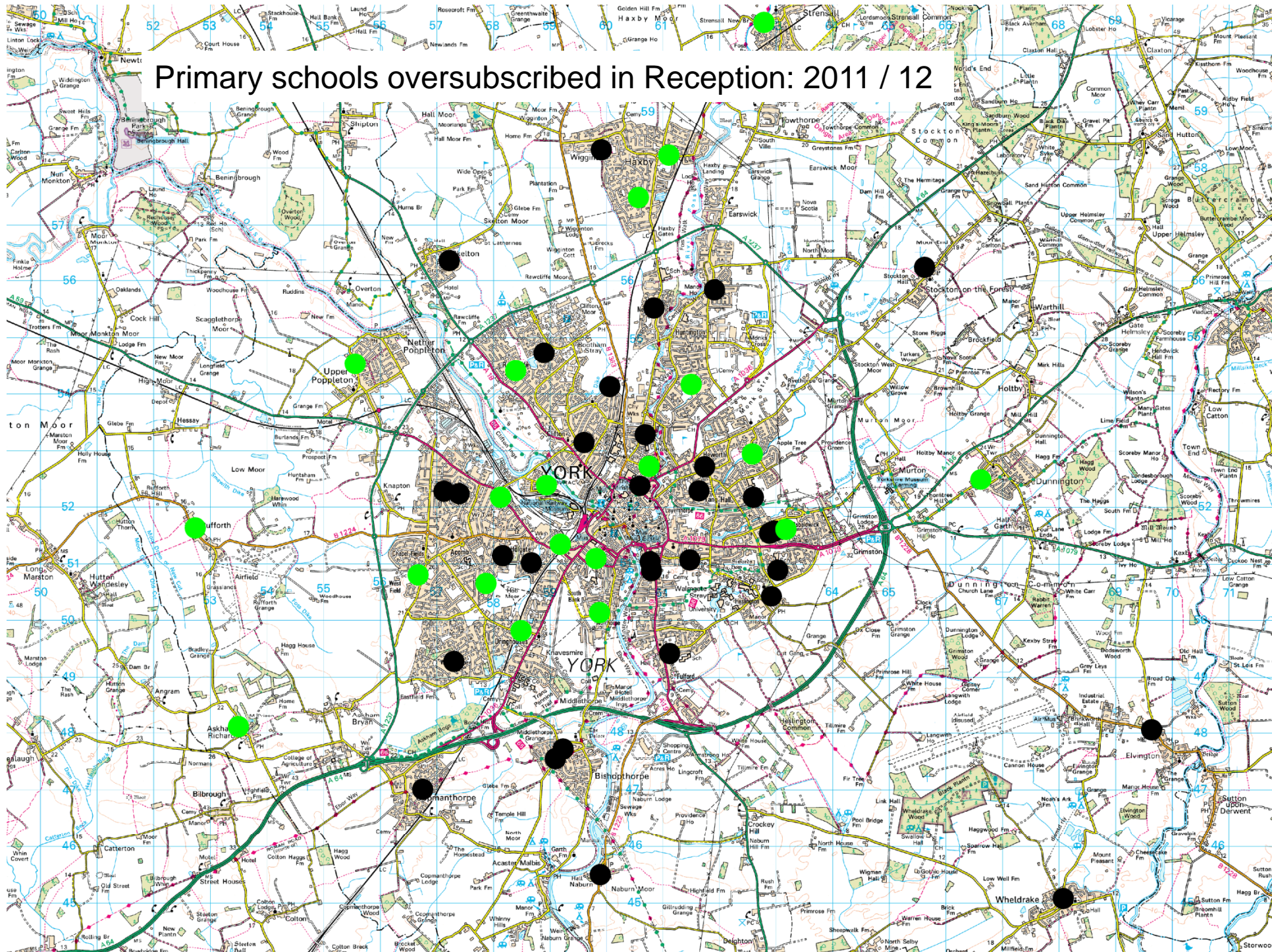
