
Dringhouses Cricket Club

- Dringhouses Cricket club was founded around 130 years ago
- Cricket has been played at St Helens Road for over 80 years
- Ground formalised in 1942
- Colonel George Alexander Eason Wilkinson
 - Inherited Dringhouses from his family
 - Left a lot of land in Dringhouses to CYC
 - for the benefit of Dringhouses residents
 - Land at St Helens Road left to be used as long as a Cricket Club exists
- Dringhouses Cricket Club now have a 99 year lease from CYC

 - Develop Womens cricket
 - Have to be able to demonstrate improvements to maintain accreditation
