The budgets may be used to give grants or to buy services and are considered by ward committees who make recommendations to support an officer decision.</p> <p>Allocations were made for April to July 2023 specifically to fund summer schemes. In August 2023 the new ward funding arrangements were introduced with each ward budget comprising a base budget element and an amount reflecting the Index of Multiple Deprivation ranking of the ward.</p>
