

Options for sites that do not meet the National Road Safety Great Britain (RSGB) criteria for a Council Funded School Crossing Patrol.

CYC have found that the Nationally Guidance provided by specialists at Road Safety GB is appropriate and relevant in terms of assessing the School Crossing Patrol (SCP) needs across the city, which determines which sites are eligible for a Council funded SCP.

Where a school or site is not eligible for a council funded patroller there is a volunteer or third party option available. Currently in York there are no SCP working who are volunteers or paid for by a third party.

However to ensure that any voluntary or third party funded SCP was legally eligible to stop traffic and be covered by The Authority's insurance there are certain rules which must be adhered in the creation of such a voluntary/ third party post:-

- The person/s would need to be appointed as a volunteer by CYC as the Authority. (the duty could be a role share between two people)
- Must be trained and provided with uniform and sign (lollipop stick) by The Authority
- Must work the times and in the location as stipulated by The Authority
- Must be cleared by Police (DBS) checked
