I have been looking at bus shelters around the ward and when looking at them most of them they are in a sorry state of affairs and so I contacted a council officer who deals with them.

The reason why I contacted him at first was to ask if they could be cleaned and who's responsibility it was to maintain them.

Many bus shelters do just need a clean and the council offer this service where they will clean a bus shelter for £20 per year, per bus shelter.

The officer went out and inspected all bus shelters and found that all were in an acceptable state once they have been cleaned.
