4. APPOINTMENT OF LOCAL AUTHORITY (LA) SCHOOL GOVERNORS

REASON: To ensure that local authority places on school governing bodies continue to be effectively filled.

RESOLVED: (i) That the actions officers had taken to handle the in-year expenditure reductions to the Early Intervention Fund and the York Youth Community Action Project, summarised in Annexes A to C of the report, be approved.

- (ii) That the Executive Member receive further updates on the implications of the expenditure reductions, including a briefing once the results of the Comprehensive Spending Review were known.
