

**Residents Parking Scheme Process**

Timescale from initial consultation

<p><b>Consultation</b></p> <p>A draft scheme and questionnaire will be sent out to all properties within the proposed area. A proposal will normally be taken forward if there is at least a 50% response rate and the majority of returns are in favour. Depending on circumstances, there is potential for individual streets to go forward from an area if the streets return is very positive whilst the areas is either low or opposed.</p>	<p>6 – 8 weeks</p>
<p>The consultation results are then reported along with a proposed scheme for approval to advertise a Traffic Regulation Order.</p>	<p>8 weeks</p>
<p>TRO preparation and advertising</p>	<p>4 - 6 weeks</p>
<p>Any objections to the proposed TRO are then reported for consideration.</p>	<p>10 – 12 weeks</p>
<p>If the objections are overturned the scheme will then be implemented. Parking services require 12 weeks’ notice before a scheme is implemented.</p>	<p>12 - 16 weeks</p>
<p>We try to give residents 6-8 weeks’ notice to prepare for implementation</p>	

Once work on a scheme begins it will take 9 - 12 months to complete
