Planning work has commenced and will incorporate a pre Decision Scrutiny report to this Committee in addition to any scrutiny involvement in the consultation process.  Update: Taking part in development of new Economic Strategy in which in-work poverty and digital inclusion/development are likely to feature. Also awaiting outcome from Corporate Scrutiny Review into Poverty – both will feed into shaping Financial Inclusion priorities.
