4. ANNUAL CHILDCARE SUFFICIENCY REPORT

Resolved: That;

- The Executive Member write to Education Minister concerning the move from automatic allocation to form filling for funded places for 2 year olds and the barrier to access this is causing families.
- ii. The content of the report be noted and agreed before it is shared with elected council members in line with statutory guidance.
- iii. The Executive Member notes the work done by officers to meet with DfE and Regional Organisations to raise York's concerns over funding and retention in the service, and, following on from the consideration of the issue in November, that the final report is briefed to the two local MPs.

5. EARLY YEARS STRATEGY

Resolved: That:

- The final wording of the Early Years Partnership Board Strategic Plan (Annex 1 of the published report) be delegated to the Assistant Director Education and Skills for completion.
