Notice of Decision

5. THE DETERMINATION OF SECTION 52(2) APPLICATION BY LESLEY COOKE, LICENSING MANAGER FOR THE LICENSING AUTHORITY, CITY OF YORK COUNCIL FOR REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE IN RESPECT OF SLAVIC FOODS, 47A CRICHTON AVENUE, YORK, YO30 6EF (CYC-069000).

Hearing reconvened in private session at 11:13 hours on 5 September 2024.

PRESENT: Councillors Cuthbertson (Chair), Knight, and Melly.

The Sub-Committee resolved to revoke the licence for the premises (Option 5) on the grounds that the premises is not upholding the licensing objectives of the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance, and the protection of children from harm.

Full reasons for the Sub-Committee's decision will be included in the detailed Decision Letter which will be provided to the Applicant, Premises Licence Holder, and the Representor in due course.

There is a right of appeal for the Applicant and the Representor to the Magistrates' Court against this decision. Any appeal to the Magistrates Court must be made within 21 days of receipt of the Decision Letter and sent to the following address:
