34. THE DETERMINATION OF AN APPLICATION BY HELEN HOWLETT, SENIOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION OFFICER FOR A REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE SECTION 52(2) IN RESPECT OF THE JUBILEE, BALFOUR STREET, YORK, YO26 4YU. (CYC- 009091)

Members considered an application by Helen Howlett, Senior Environmental Protection Officer for a Review of the Premises Licence Section 52(2) in respect of The Jubilee, Balfour Street, York YO26 4YU.

During discussion of preliminary matters the Council's Legal representative reported that, earlier in the week, confirmation had been received that the Premises Licence Holder, would attend the hearing to address the Committee. However a phone call had today been received from Enterprise Inns Plc confirming the Premises Licence Holder's non attendance due to sickness. The Brewery had indicated that they would have no objections to the Hearing proceeding, as long as no additional conditions were attached

to the licence other than the 3 conditions recommended by Environmental Protection Unit, at paragraph 6 of the report.
