During the whole of the period that the premises are open to the public for the sale of intoxicating liquor the whole of the premises or part of the premises designated for the purposes of the special hours certificate, shall be bona fide used for purposes of providing the persons resorting to the premises,

- a) In the case of casino premises, gaming facilities and substantial refreshment, and
- b) In the case of any other premises, music and dancing and substantial refreshment, to which the sale of intoxicating liquor is ancillary.
