Councillor A D'Agorne (Ward Councillor and Representative for York Green Party)

I do recall significant concerns at planning committee seeking this provision. Given the absence of any parking provision in the student development, we were keen to ensure a safe crossing point to access the bus stop for students travelling to the University campus. This proposal is the most effective way to provide a crossing point directly to the bus stop. I think residents will be concerned about displacement parking, but officers advised against requiring funding from the developer for an extended respark scheme. The traffic island will also increase safety for delivery vehicles and cyclists turning out of or into the new development being close to the new vehicle access, (this would be enhanced by changing the central markings to create a 'turning lane'). This may need to be discussed with the most directly affected residents, although I think many of these mostly HMOs.
