- 2. The City of York Pathway Team was rated Good in our most recent Ofsted inspection, 2016.
- 3. "The local authority has high aspirations for their care leavers. A high percentage are in employment and training. There is a range of suitable and safe accommodation options for care leavers. York has a strong track record in supporting care leavers to remain with their foster carers after their 18th birthdays. Good pathway planning supports preparation for independence, when it is safe and appropriate to do so."
- 4. The team currently works with around 100 care leavers who were previously looked after by the Local Authority. The team focus on offering advice and support through identified, assessed need. The team has Pathway workers, an Accommodation worker and an ETE worker who work together to meet the needs of our care leavers.
