Public protection objected to the above premises license grant on grounds of public nuisance, however, I have mediated with the applicant and so long as the following conditions are attached to the premises license grant then our objection is withdrawn:

Condition 1.

Whilst regulated entertainment is taking place, all doors and windows shall remain closed, except for the purposes of ingress and egress.

Condition 2.

The doors to the roof terrace shall be closed and remain closed after 9pm each day.

Condition 3.

Customers will not be allowed on the roof terrace after 9pm each day.

Condition 4.

Signs shall be displayed near the exits reminding customers to respect the needs of those living nearby and to leave the premises as quietly as possible.

Condition 5.

A direct contact number for the duty manager shall be made available to residents living in the vicinity of the premises.

Condition 6.

Any complaints received from local premises to be acted upon immediately to reduce the noise levels. Any noise complaints to be logged in a log book and actions taken also logged.

Condition 7.

The Log book shall be made available to the Local Authority on request.
