**Please give a general description of the premises (please read guidance note 1)**

It is intended that the proposed premises will operate as a food led public house on the ground floor with limited "one-off" occasional regulated entertainment and with unlicensed Hotel accommodation incorporating some 86 bedrooms on the upper floors at first, second and third floor levels.

The details of the development are shown on the drawings identified below, deposited with this application in respect of which an application for Planning Permission has been submitted.

It is proposed that the permitted hours for licensable activities for these premises should be :-

Monday to Sunday : 10:00 – 00:30 inclusive with the premises closing to the general public 30 minutes thereafter. However, the premises will remain open 24 hours a day to residents in the adjacent Hotel accommodation.

This application seeks to licence the premises specifically to authorise under the Licensing Act 2003 the following activities:

1. Occasional and "one-off" regulated entertainment comprising: Live music and amplified voice, recorded music by music systems and similar forms of entertainment.
2. Exhibition of a film principally educational videos in conjunction with occasional conferences or special events.
3. The sale of alcohol and such regulated entertainment as specified in the appropriate boxes below.
4. The provision of late night refreshment after 23.00

The appropriate drawings deposited with this application are :-

1. Indicative aerial photograph identifying the site.
2. Indicative site location / arrangement plan – X1889/AM3 – site edged in red
3. Detailed ground floor general arrangement licensing plan with the public area hatched pink and the toilet accommodation hatched maroon – X1889/AM1
4. Indicative upper floor plan – unlicensed – X1889/AM2

Please note that the internal area hatched pink is intended to be used (as required) for all licensable activities. The inclusion of certain limited regulated entertainment is for "one-off" occasional events and will not form part of the normal operating procedure.

The applicant has considered the cumulative impact policy apparently applicable to this area.

For the avoidance of doubt, the proposed offering is not a "vertical drinking establishment" which that Policy seeks to regulate nor will it comprise a "late night drink led or entertainment premises".

The proposed food dominated premises are aimed at providing a dining facility principally to a market comprising of cross generational families, business persons and those staying within the hotel accommodation. Due to the nature of the operation, it is not anticipated that any point there will be an en-masse vacation of customers giving rise to any flash points. The proposed bar servery within the premises which also will incorporate a food servery and order point reflects the nature of the premises.

It is not anticipated that the premises will form part of a drinking circuit.

Due to the nature of the offering it is not anticipated that the proposed development will adversely affect crime and disorder or public nuisance. On the contrary, it is anticipated that the redevelopment of this site will improve the area, providing jobs for the local community and a new food led facility with budget Hotel accommodation within the City Centre.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below

1. The use of doorstaff will be risk assessed on an ongoing basis by the licence holder of premises supervisor. Where engaged, door staff shall be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
2. Alcoholic and other drinks may not be removed from the premises in open containers save for consumption in any external area provided for that purpose or for consumption in the adjacent hotel.
3. Staff will receive training on matters concerning underage sales, drugs policies and operating procedures.
4. There shall be a zero tolerance policy in relation to drugs at the premises and there shall be regular checks by management to prevent the use of drugs by patrons. Drugs seized shall be stored securely and handed to the police.
5. The premises shall operate a proof of age scheme and will require photographic identification from any person who appears to be under the age of 21 years.
6. The management of the premises will liaise with police on issues of local concern or disorder.
7. CCTV will be installed with recording facilities such recordings shall be retained for a period of 31 days and made available within a reasonable time upon request by the police, such as to cover the main entrance to the premises.
8. There shall be no drinks promotions at the premises which are inconsistent with the need to promote responsible drinking.

**c) Public safety**

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below

1. To comply with the reasonable requirements of the fire officer from time to time.
2. The premises will have adequate safety and fire fighting equipment and such equipment will be maintained in good operational order.
3. Staff will be trained on matters of safety, evacuation and use of emergency equipment as required.
4. Spillages and breakages will be removed as soon as possible to reduce the risk to patrons and staff.
5. Toughened glasses will be used in the premises where appropriate.
6. Fire Exits and means of escape shall be kept clear and in good operational condition.

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below

1. Where appropriate, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting the public respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
2. Patrons will be encouraged by staff to leave quietly and respect the interests of the occupiers of any nearby noise sensitive premises, Where appropriate the licensee or a suitable staff member will monitor patrons leaving at the closing time.
3. Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties.
4. Contact numbers for local taxi firm(s) shall be kept at the premises and made available to patrons requiring a taxi.

**e) The protection of children from harm**

1) The restrictions set out in the Licensing Act 2003 will apply. No unusual or additional risks of harm to children have been identified.

2) No films or videos of any description will be shown so that they can be viewed by persons under the age of any applicable BBFC/Local Authority certification.

3) Children under the age of 16 shall not be permitted to enter the premises after 21:00 unless dining with an adult or attending a pre booked function or resident in the adjacent hotel.

4) There shall be adequate controls in place including staff training to safeguard against the sale of alcohol to persons under 18 years.

5) The premises supervisor or appointed staff member shall ensure that when children are admitted to the premises their presence is not inconsistent with the style of operation of the premises at that time and the licensable activities that are being carried out.

6) Policies in relation to children shall be adequately communicated to patrons by staff or through appropriate signage.
