DMO Comment on the evidence as a whole					
The application sought to record the route as a bridleway. However there is a considerable amount of vehicular use (mechanically propelled and cycle). The Natural Environment and Rural Communities Act 2006 has extinguished rights for mechanically propelled vehicles. Therefore it is more appropriate to make an order to record the route as a restricted byway (open to walkers, horse riders, and cyclists). There is no evidence refuting the application and the evidence before CYC more than meets the statutory test for making an order.


